FORTY-SIXTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT

OF THE
St. George's Society
OF THE
CITY OF TORONTO
FOR THE YEAR 1880.

The year having elapsed for which the Committee of Management were elected, it becomes their duty to present this their Annual Report and Financial Statement, and it is with much gratification that they are enabled to state that the Society is in a most sound substantial condition.

The number of applicants for assistance has been, through the year, about the same as last year; but this has chiefly arisen from the circumstance of a larger number of Emigrants arriving in the months of June and August, seeking assistance. Generally speaking, work appears to have been more readily obtained by residents in the City.

The resources of the Society have been well sustained during the year; no lack of means ever having been felt.

The balance in the hands of the Treasurer, at the commencement of the year was \$614.20; the receipts during the year have been \$2372.62, making a total of \$2986.82.

The expenditure of the Society for the relief of the destitute, printing, advertising, office expenses, &c., &c., has amounted to \$2404.89, leaving a balance in the hands of the Treasurer of \$581.93.

RELIEF.

1570 applicants have been relieved during the year to the amount of \$1111.74, from the ordinary resources of the Society, which is very nearly the same as last year.

The relief given being in the same way as in previous years, viz.: Bread, Meat, Lodgings, Meals, Railway Passages, Money Payments, &c.

Four orders have been given for interment in the Lots of the Society in St. James's Cemetery.

Visitations among the recipients of the Society's benefactions by the Committee, have been numerous.

MEMBERSHIP.

There have been seven Life Members, and forty-eight Annual Members elected during the year.

In accordance with the usual custom, a Committee of Revision has gone over the roll of Membership, and, after making the fullest allowances, have been compelled most reluctantly to strike off quite a number of names for long arrearages.

One Honorary Life Member, the Rev. S. Givins, has died during the year. The Rev. gentleman was held in the highest esteem and respect by all who knew him.

As also, four Annual Members have died, viz. : Mr. W. B. Butler, an old an active citizen ; Mr. A. Cayley, a young gentleman of a very amiable character ; Mr. S. S. Parsons, and Mr. M. L. Simms, were, both of them, gentlemen of high respectability and culture.

The number of members now on the books, after making these additions and subtractions, being 16 Honorary Life Members, 207 Life Members, 335 Ordinary Members ; a considerable portion of these latter still being in arrear.

ANNUAL RELIGIOUS SERVICES.

The Annual Religious Services were, according to the usual custom, held in the St. James's Cathedral, on Sunday afternoon, April 18th ; and in the Metropolitan Methodist Church, on the 25th of April : the use of both Churches being granted with the greatest cordiality.

The Sermon in St. James's Cathedral was preached by the Rev. C. H. Mockridge, B.D., now of Hamilton ; and the one in the Metropolitan, by the Rev. J. B. Clarkson, M.A., the Chaplains of the Society ; and were both of a very practical, useful character.

The collection in the St. James's Cathedral amounted to \$20.00, and in the Metropolitan, \$85.00.

DINNER ON ST. GEORGE'S DAY.

The Annual Dinner on St. George's Day was held at the Windsor Hotel : about one hundred gentleman sat down thereto, spending the evening in a very sociable, agreeable manner. The pecuniary gain being \$37.30.

EXCURSION TO MILTON.

An arrangement was made for an Excursion, by the Credit Valley Railroad, to Milton, on the 15th of July ; but, owing

to the strike which took place on that road a few days previously, it could not come off before the 29th, the result being that, although a pleasant day was spent, there was not any pecuniary gain resulting therefrom.

CONCERT IN ST. JAMES'S SCHOOL HOUSE.

On the 9th day of November, a Concert was given in St. James's School House, the use of which, as on former occasions, was most courteously granted by the Dean and Church Wardens. The attendance, owing, it is believed, to other attractions taking place the same evening, was not as large as was expected, yet the handsome sum of \$133.55 was realized thereby.

CHRISTMAS DISTRIBUTION.

In accordance with the time-honoured custom the annual collection for the Christmas Distribution, was made in December, by the Committee and Stewards. The amount collected was \$870.75, being, as nearly as possible, the same as last year.

There were over 7000 lbs. of Beef, 4200 lbs. of Bread, 180 lbs. of Tea, and over 700 lbs. of Sugar, distributed on the occasion ; the Beef was of a superior quality to any previously given. The distribution took place in the store lately occupied by Glover Harrison, Esq., on King Street East, and was very kindly lent by that gentleman for the purpose.

Relief was given to some 650 families, consisting of about 3400 individuals.

THE TENT.

The Tent has not been rented during the summer ; but the sum of thirty dollars has been obtained, through the kind effort of R. Caddick, Esq., for its detention two years since, when loaned to the Sons of England for their Excursion to Oshawa.
