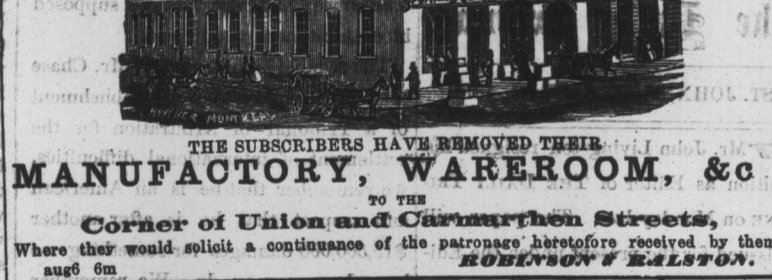

By Telegraph. **British and Foreign.** [By Telegraph to Associated Press.] **LONDON, Sept. 20.** The Bishops of the Church of England were present at the opening of the 18th Catholic Congress at Cologne to-day.

Don Carlos is said to have written a letter to the Pope promising a speedy renewal of the Carlist insurrection.

The charges against Edmond About are stated to be publishing hostile articles in German territory, and circulating them in Lorraine. The prisoner has sent word to President Thiers expressing him to be calm and to do nothing in his case which will impair France.

The French Ministers are considering measures to secure tranquility on the anniversary of the establishment of the first Republic which occurs on the 23rd.

Verifiability of private property at sea in time of war is one of the subjects of the discussion of the Empereur at Berlin, and the Premier of Austria, Russia, and Prussia, seem interested for final establishment of this principle.
