ANNUAL REPORT.
POULTRY NOTES.The Poultry Year at a glance. (Attention for facts when they are intended for sale use, and to compare milk in any state from fresh to thick. This should be kept in connection with a grain diet.)

Look for parasites when your young
chicks or turkeys begin at once to
drop. They are probably troubled with
lice, or the application of kerosene and
carbolic acid - no more than five drops of
acid in a tablespoonful of kerosene -
touching the neck, head and vent, will probably
kill the parasites. But, of course, the
coops and nurseries must be cleaned also.

SECK NOTES. - Add a little to the ration of each house during severe cold weather. The animal must be kept warm, and this requires fuel in the shape of food.

Oil meal is the best substitute for roots
for sheep in winter. When a sheep gets
a gill of oil meal it will not have the
stronches, which is a indication of
dryness of the bowels or constipation.
Wheat bran should always be mixed with
grain for sheep.

When hogs have the run of a field, it
is the case that they will get fat, and
therefore it is to be feared all over, that
they will get quite fat. The corn
should be mixed with bran or oats, and
only half the bulk of the feed should be
of the corn or oatmeal mixture. Such
fevered feed is not the thing to eat.
When hogs are fed all the corn meal
they will eat, one third of it is wasted.
It is not so with the bran and oats, and
the corn meal in it is undigested. It can
also be seen with the simple magnifying
glass of common sense. - F. D. Carter.

SELECTING A FAMILY HORSE. - Among the good points to be noticed in the selection of the family horse, docility and gentleness must be kept well in front. If the woman and children are to share in the use and care of the horse, nothing vicious should be tolerated.
