

## BILL.

An Act to incorporate the Association called LaSociété Ecclésiastique de St. Michel.

HEREAS an Association of members of the Ro-Preamble. man Catholic Clergy of the Diocese of Quebec, hath existed since the fifth of June, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, under the name of the "Société 5 " Ecclésiastique de Saint Michel," the sole object of which is to assist the Members of the said Association in case of infirmity, illness, or old age: And whereas the said Association is composed of the persons hereinafter named, and others, who have set forth by their Petition 10 that the incorporation of the said Association would increase and secure the advantages resulting therefrom, and have prayed that they and their successors may be incorporated, in conformity with the regulations and provisions hereinafter mentioned; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

15 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Certain per-

- the Reverend Charles François Baillargeon, Louis Proulx, sons incorpor-Charles Félix Cazeau, Edouard Gabriel Plante and such other persons as are now, or shall under the provisions of this Act and the By-laws of the said Association be or 20 become members thereof, and their successors, shall be, and they are hereby constituted a Body Politic and Corporate, under the name of "La Société Ecclésiastique de St. Michel," and shall, under the said name, from time ' time and at all times hereafter, be entitled to purch
- 25 acquire, hold, possess, take and receive, to and for the pur poses of the said Corporation, any immoveable property lying within this Province, not exceeding in yearly value the sum of one thousand five hundred pounds currency, and the same to sell, alienate and dispose of, and acquire 35 others in their stead for the purposes above mentioned.
- II. And be it enacted, That all and every, the personal Property of property belonging to the said Association, and all debts, Association vested in claims and demands, due to the said Association at the Corporation. time of the passing of this Act, shall be, and they are here-40 by vested in the said Corporation hereby constituted, and the said Corporation shall be liable for all debts due by, or claims against, the said Association.

III. And be it enacted, That the By-laws, Rules and By-laws of Regulations of the said Association, in force at the time Association to be those of 45 of the passing of this Act, shall be and continue to be the Corporation By-laws, Rules, and Regulations of the said Corporation, until altered

until modified, altered or repealed by the said Corporation; and the Officers and Administrators of the said Association at the time of the passing of this Act, and each of them, shall continue to fulfil their respective duties, as Officers or Administrators of the said Corporation, and to manage and conduct the affairs thereof, until others shall be appointed in their stead, under the said By-laws, Rules and Orders.
