




REICHARDSON'S WAR OF 1812

With notes and a life of the author. By Alexander

The foundation of this history is Major John Richardson's book printed at Brockville, Ont., in 1842, and entitled "A Soldier and Doctor's Narrative of the Operations of the Right Division of the Canadian Army." The original text has been corrected, and in addition numerous notes and historical authorities on both sides have been added; also a life of Richardson, a genealogy of his family and bibliography of his works, numerous maps, battle plans, portraits and views, and a facsimile letter of Major Richardson's, dated Feb. 4th, 1813, describing the battle of Frenchtown.

"John Richardson, the author of the book now reprinted by Mr. Caselmann, the scope of which is best described by the original title as 'containing a full and detailed narrative of the operations of the Right Division of the Canadian Army,' was certainly one of the most prolific and versatile of early native Canadian writers. Besides numerous magazine articles, he was responsible for the production of seven novels, four historical works, and a heroic poem of 188 stanzas entitled 'Tecumseh.' One of these novels, 'Wacousta,' which is considered his 'masterpiece' by Mr. Caselmann, passed through no less than six editions and with three others was reprinted recently in 1888 by a New York publishing house.

"The work now edited by Mr. Caselmann was first published in book form at Brockville in 1842. It was printed in such a slovenly manner that the author declared that he would gladly have burned the entire edition. The editor has corrected the misprints and errors in dates and carefully revised the official documents to which he has added a considerable number of important letters. Among the latter that written by Richardson himself on the 4th of February, 1813, describing the battle of the River Raisin and now reproduced in facsimile, deserves special mention. Mr. Caselmann's life of the author is a noteworthy contribution to the history of Canadian literature and his notes to the text are remarkably accurate, indicating great industry and research. The volume is nicely illustrated with maps and portraits, many of which have never been published before."—*E. C. Criddle, in Review of Historical Publications Relating to Canada*.
