




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

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Hansomest and Best Bred Trotting Stallion in Canada

• BOOKMAKER •

(STANDARD).

The attention of trotting-horse breeders is called to this princely bred trotting stallion, as being not only one of the most fashionable bred horses in America, but because he has many recommendations not possessed by any other stallion. His sire, Harold, has thirteen in the 2:30 list, and is the sire of the queen of the trotting turf, the famous MAUD S., 2:08 $\frac{3}{4}$. Harold is also the sire of Lord Russell who stands at the farm of A. J. Alexander, Ky., at \$200 for the season; (the highest fee of any untried stallion in America.) Harolden, dam of Algath, 4 years old; record, 2:23. Bicara, dam of Pancost, 2:21 $\frac{1}{4}$; sold by Public Auction for \$28,000; sire of Patron, 3 years old, 2:19 $\frac{1}{2}$, (half interest sold to C. Emery, of Cleveland, for \$12,500); also Consuela, dam of Cannnaught; record, 2:24. These are the first three of his daughters that were bred.

Bookmaker's dam, Wildwood, was sired by the famous Kentucky stallion Nutwood, 2:18 $\frac{3}{4}$. He by Belmont, out of the dam of MAUD S. Nutwood, sold at the great Glenview sale, 1886, for \$22,000, and 61 of his get brought the unprecedented sum of \$100,700, an average of \$1,650. This included all his wealing foals of 1886 and yearling foals of 1885. The grand dam of Bookmaker was Wild Rose, by Rysdyk's Hambletonian. This mare was the dam of Duquesne, 2:15 $\frac{1}{4}$. No stallion in Canada combines so many speed-producing lines as Bookmaker.

He traces four times to Old Abdallah, three times to Rysdyk's Hambletonian, three times to Imported Bellfounder, once to Alexander's Abdallah (the sire of Goldsmith Maid, 2:14), once to Mambrino Chief (the sire of Lady Thorne, 2:18 $\frac{1}{4}$); and with all of the above he combines the same animals that produced MAUD S., 2:08 $\frac{3}{4}$.

Bookmaker, at the Industrial Exhibition held at Toronto, 1886, was winner of the first premium for best 3-year-old roadster stallion. Also winner of silver medal for best roadster stallion any age, over a very large number of the best roadster stallion in Canada. Two weeks after at London he won first premium for 3-year-old roadster stallion, and diploma for best roadster stallion any age; stamping himself beyond doubt or controversy as being not only the best breed but the handsomest stallion in Canada. Bookmaker has grown and greatly improved on his 3-year-old form. Breeder will please notice that Harold, Nutwood and Belmont has each added four of their get during this last season to the 2:30 list.

He was foaled May 1, 1883, and was bred at Woodburn Farm, Kentucky.

In color he is a beautiful bay, with hind ankles white. He is of a very rangy form, stands 15 hands 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches high, in road condition weighs 1,100 lbs., showing immense bone and great muscular power. With only the handling incidental to harness gentling, he has shown quarters in forty-four seconds.

Breeders will notice that Woodburn Farm is using only sons of Harold as their young stallions in the std. Eleven Woodburn trotters beat 2:30 last season.

Positively limited to 50 mares; Chicago Volunteer mares preferred.

TERMS—\$25.00 for season, payable by note January 1st, 1888. Mares not proving in foal can be returned next season free, if horse living and in my possession. A large number of mares have been spoken for but book is now open and applications will be received, until the desired number obtained; after which no more received, positively! as I intend training him this fall.
