An Act to amend and extend the provisions of chapter fifty-three of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, respecting Building Societies.

An Act to amend and extend the provisions of Chapter fifty-three of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting Building Societies"

ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-Preamble.

lative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for any Building Society now established, or capital of hereafter to be established, at any general meeting of the shareholders Societies 5 thereof, to limit the number of shares and the capital of such society.

- 2. It shall be lawful, notwithstanding anything in chapter fifty-three How by-laws of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, or in the rules or by-laws maybe repealof any Building Society heretofore established, to the contrary, for two-edor amendthirds of the shareholders present in person or by proxy, at any general 10 meeting of the shareholders of such Society, of which meeting, and the object thereof, thirty days' previous notice shall have been given by cironlar, addressed and mailed to each shareholder, or by advertisement published once a week for four consecutive weeks in some newspaper published in the city, town or county in which the head office of the so-15 ciety shall be kept,-to alter repeal or amend any of the rules or bylaws of such society.
- 3. It shall belawful for the Governor General in Council to appoint, Apppointand at pleasure to remove an officer to be called "The Inspector of ment of Parilling Societies" at a salary of 8 per annum, over and above Building Building Societies," at a salary of \$ 20 his necessary travelling expenses.
- 4. It shall be the duty of such Inspector to examine the books, secu- Duties of rities and affairs of all building societies and to make yearly reports to Inspector. the Governor in Council upon the financial condition and arranagement of such societies, and to make and provide, subject to the approval of the 25 Auditor General of the Province, an uniform rule or scale of discount for the valuation of the mortgage securities of such societies by which a present value at any time may be ascertained, and render the system of valuation general among all societies.
- 5. It shall be the duty of all building societies, after the making Duty of 80 and providing of such rule or scale as aforesaid, approved as afore-societies as to said, to adopt the same in determining the value of such mortgage valuation of securities for the purpose of declaring dividends or estimating annual securities. profits.
- 6. A rate sufficient to pry the Inspector's salary and travelling ex- Rate for pay-85 penses shall be levied annually on each society in proportion to their ment of Inspector. respective paid-up capitals, whether capitalized or otherwise.

Inspector to have access to books, papers &c.

7. It shall be the duty of the Secretary and Treasurer of every such society, or in the absence of such Secretary or Treasurer, of the President or Vice-President of such society to submit to and suffer to be inspected by such Inspector, the books, papers and securities of such society, and such officer shall give to such Inspector all such information 5 as he may require in reference to such books, papers and securities and the affairs generally of such society.

Penalties on Officers of society refusing such access.

- 8. Any Secretary, Treasurer, President or Vice-President of any auch society who shall refuse to submit the books, papers and securities of the society or any of them to such Inspector, or who shall 10 refuse to give all such information as it may be in his power to give when required so to do by such Inspector, and any person who shall obstruct, hinder or interfere with such Inspector or any assistant employed by him in the examination of such books, papers or securities, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, on conviction before any 16 one or more of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the city or county where the offence shall be committed, be condemned to be imprisoned in the common gaol of the county for any period not exceeding calendar months, or to the payment of a fine of not less than nor more than \$ to be levied by distress of the of- 20
- fonder's goods and chattels; and the Act chapter one hundred and three of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada respecting duties of Justices of the Peace out of session, in relation to Summary Convictions and Orders and the forms and proceedings thereby provided, as far as they can be adopted thereto, shall apply to offences under this Act. And no 25 dividend or profits shall be declared or divided until such information is given as may be required by the Inspector.

9. The thirty-minth section of the Act shall be amended by adding shares in full the following provise thereto; Provided always, that any share or shares may at any time be paid up in full and capitalized, and any such 20 share or shares heretofore paid, in such manner, shall be as valid as if the same had been paid by periodical subscription.
