

C A P. LXVII.

An Act for empowering His Majesty to authorize the Importation and Exportation of certain Articles into and from the West Indies, South America, and Newfoundland, until Six Weeks after the Commencement of the next Seffion of Par-[3d June 1813.] liament.

HEREAS it is neceffary further to continue for a limited Time the Powers vested in His Majesty, by virtue of an Act passed in the present Session of Parliament, intituled An Act for in- 53 G.3. c 12. demnifying fuch Perfons as have advised or acted under an Order in Council for allowing the Importation of certain Articles into the West Indies, and for permitting fuch Importation until the Thirtieth Day of June One thousand eight hundred and thirteen; be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majefty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That it fhall and may be lawful for His Majefty His Majelty, from and after the paffing of this Act, and until Six Weeks may authoafter the Commencement of the next Sellion of Parliament, by any Order rize the Goor Orders in Council for that Purpole to be iffued, further to authorize vernor of any of the Welt the Governor or Lieutenant Governor of any of the Islands in the Welt India Islands, Indies to His Majesty belonging, in which Description the Bahama and &c. to permit Bermuda or Somers Islands are included, or of any of the Lands and Terri- the Importatories to His Majesty belonging on the Continent of South America, to portation of 5 Z permit

permit the Importation of Corn, Grain, Meal, Flour, Bread, Bifcuit, and Rice, into any of the faid Iflands, Lands, and Territories, in any unarmed Ship or Veffel not belonging to *France*, or to the Subjects or Inhabitants thereof, or of any Port or Place annexed to the Territories of *France*, and to export therefrom in fuch Ship or Veffel, Rum and Molaffes, and any other Goods and Commodities whatfoever, except Sugar, Indigo, Cotton Wool, Coffee, and Cocoa, fubject to fuch Regulations and Reftrictions as fhall be contained in fuch Order or Orders, and to fuch Inftructions, as the Governor or Lieutenant Governor may from Time to Time receive from His Majefty, fignified by One of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State.

Provision for a more ready. Supply of certain Articles to Newfoundland.

II. And whereas it is neceffary to provide in like Manner for a more ready Supply of certain Articles to the Island of Newfoundland, than can now be had, under an Act paffed in the Twenty-eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act for regulating the Trade between the Subjects of Ilis Majefly's Colonies and Plantations in North America, and in the West India Islands, and the Countries belonging to the United, States of America, and between His Majcfly's faid Subjects and the Foreign Islands in the West Indies; be it therefore enacted, That from and after the paffing of this Act, and until the Expiration of Six Weeks from the Commencement of the next Seffion of Parliament, it shall and may be lawful for His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to permit or to authorize the Governor or Lieutenant Governor of Newfoundland, in fuch Manner and under fuch Restrictions as to His Majesty, with the Advice of His Privy Council, thall feem fit, fubject to fuch Instructions as may be from Time to Time fignified to fuch Governor or Lieutenant Governor, by One of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State, to permit, when the Neceffity of the Cafe shall appear to His Majesty, with the Advice of His Privy Council, to require it, from Time to Time, the Importation into the faid Island of Newfoundland, of Corn, Grain, Meal, Flour, Rice, and Ground Provisions, and the Exportation from the faid Ifland of Newfoundland, of any Articles, Goods, and Commodities that shall be mentioned in fuch Order of His Majelty in Council, in any unarmed Ship or Veflel not belonging to France, or to the Subjects or Inhabitants thereof, or of any Port or Place annexed to the Territories of France.

Matters done III. And be it further enacted, That all Acts done by virtue of any under Orders fuch Order or Orders in Council, shall be valid and legal, any Act for in Council Acts of Parliament to the contrary notwithstanding,
