LOCKED UP AT HEADQUARTERS.

Preliminary Examination Fixed for To-Morrow.

Both the "Doctor" and Mrs. Andrews Agreed to Return as They can Now Be Tried for Any Offense That May Be Preferred Against Them—Both Take the Matter Unconcernedly—An Immense Crowd Witness Their Arrival at the Station.

Irwin R. Andrews, alias "Doc" Andrews, for the second time in his life is behind the bars at Headquarters. This time he is not alone. He has his wife with him.

They arrived in Toronto on the 1.35 train yesterday afternoon in charge of Detective Burrows. By some means the fact that the couple had agreed to return from Buffalo without extradition proceedings had become known, and an excited and curious crowd waited the arrival of the train at the Union Station. Every one wanted to see Andrews, and perchance his wife.

The train arrived on time and the anxious waiters made another effort to penetrate the dense crowd which surrounded them. Detective Sheehan who had joined the party at the Queen's wharf, was the first notable to be seen. The prisoner was beside the detective.

## WARS MAY SHAKE THE WORLD

THE FRANCO-RUSSIAN ALLIANCE REGARDED AS DANGEROUS.

BRUSSEL, Nov. 6.—In a notable lecture published on Friday The Koolhaes Zeitung said: "The ultimate ends of the Franco-Russian alliance cannot be achieved without the annexation to France of the whole left bank of the Rhine and the absorption by Russia of the Danube principalities and Turkey to the Bosphorus."

"The struggle for supremacy," he says, "may begin in the Mediterranean against the will of the British Empire."

Numerous reports as to the Franco-Russian alliance have been published in the press. It is stated that Russia has offered to guarantee Italy against attack from France in return for Italy's promise to help England in any event. Russia is negotiating with Greece for the use of a naval station on the island of Paros.

## KICKED HIS WIFE TO DEATH.

Mr. Gladstone Says No New Bills Will Be Introduced This Session—Questioned as to His Stand.

DRESDEN, Oct. 6.—A most brutal murder was committed here this forenoon. Henry Richman, 35, knocked down and kicked his wife to death. Richman has always been cruel to his wife, and it is said he often threatened to do the terrible deed. She had left him several times, but was always induced to return.

Yesterday Richman began abusing his wife, and this morning after he had left for work she had a dry look for food, but it is supposed that he suspected what she would do for her return. She tried to escape, but he ran down stairs. The coroner's inquest was held this afternoon and a verdict of violent murder was brought in. The magistrate's trial will be held to-day.

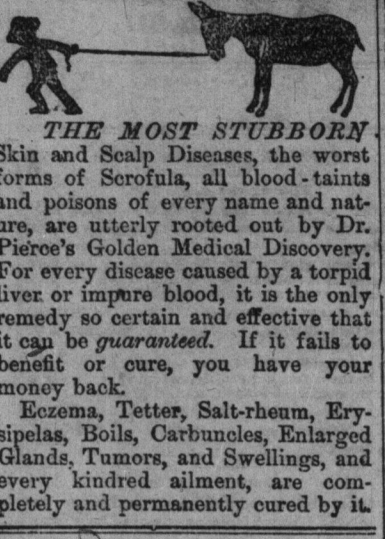
