THE IRON RESOURCES OF COLUMBIA

Report of a Special Committee Which was Submitted at the Last Meeting of the Voters' League—Some Suggestions.

Below is published the full report which P. R. Smith, for the committee on iron and steel manufacture, read at Tuesday night's meeting of the Voters' League.

We, your committee appointed to investigate the resources of this province in iron ore with a view of determining the economic value of the same, together with a comparison of the cost of manufacture and prospective markets, are in honor bound to report that the abundance of raw materials has been established, but to make the following report: Ore Deposits.

Of the developed properties, upon which a value from an economic standpoint may be based, those of the Texada Island may be cited. It here the Puget Sound Iron Co. own 2,700 acres situated on the south-east side of the island.
