FACULTY OF MEDICINE.

This Faculty will be conducted in Toronto as heretofore, and those who complete the prescribed curriculum, and pass a satisfactory examination, will receive the degree of Doctor of Medicine from the Senate of the University.

The lectures commence on the first day of October, and continue six months.

Any further information may be obtained by applying to the Dean of the Medical Faculty, the Hon. Dr. Rolph, Gerrard Street, Toronto.

DEGREE OF M. A.

This degree is conferred in course on all Bachelors in Arts of three years' standing, whose mental improvement and moral character have appeared satisfactory to the authorities of the University. Application must be made by letter to the President, one month prior to Convocation. The fee is the same as for the degree of B. A.

PREPARATORY DEPARTMENT.

This Department sustains to the University the relation of a Grammar School, and is designed to qualify pupils for the University Course, or to give them a thorough elementary training in the following subjects, namely:—Arithmetic, Geography, History, English Grammar, Book-keeping, Algebra, Natural Philosophy, and the French, Latin, and Greek Languages.

Those presenting themselves for admission into this department must be 12 years of age, and able to pass an examination in Geography, and Arithmetic as far as fractions.

Terms and Vacations.

The Collegiate year begins on the *last Thursday* in August, and ends on the *Wednesday next* preceding the last Wednesday of May.

This period is divided into two Terms, between which there is a Recess at Christmas of two weeks.

Convocation is held on the *last* day of the Collegiate year, and is followed by the Summer Vacation.

Candidates for admission may be examined either on the day after Convocation, or on the day before the opening in August.

EXPENSES.

Board in College Refectory, including furnished room and fuel, \$2 a week; washing and lights extra.

Board may be had also in private families at prices varying from \$2 to \$2 50 a week.

Tuition, \$12 a term, or \$24 for the year. The charge is the same whatever studies are pursued.

Payment for tuition is required *in advance* for each term; for board in advance for each half term.

The charge for *incidentals* is \$4 per annum, payable on admission.

Any student wishing to attend the College on a Scholarship must bring an order from the owner of the Scholarship.

No Scholarship is available unless paid up in full.

Students not having the use of Scholarships will be charged the customary tuition fees, as specified above.

The total expense for board, instruction and incidentals, is about \$100 a year.

PRIZES.

The sum of \$300 was generously given to the College by His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, on the occasion of his recent visit to this Province, with a view to the establishment of prizes. This money has been duly invested by the authorities of the College, and the interest will be annually expended in the bestowment of a Gold Medal and two prizes, to be styled the Prince of Wales' Medal and Prizes.

The Medal will be awarded to that student of the graduating class who may have sustained the highest standing in all the prescribed subjects of the curriculum, during the four years of study.

The remaining two Prizes will be awarded in the same way to the second and third best students of the graduating class.

In addition to the above there are three prizes established by John George Hodgins, Esq., L.L.B., Deputy Superintendent of Education, who, several years since donated the handsome sum of \$635 for their permanent endowment.

The first of these is styled the *Ryerson* prize, the second the *Webster* prize, and the third the *Hodgins* prize. The *Ryerson* prize will be annually awarded to that member of the Freshman class who may evince the best knowledge of Scripture History; the *Webster* and *Hodgins* prizes are open for competition to the Junior and Senior classes, and will be awarded to the respective authors of the first and second best English essays on such subject as may be assigned by the Senate.

DISCIPLINE.

Students connected with the College will be expected to conduct themselves with propriety, and to observe all regulations imposed by the President and Faculty.

A record is kept of each Student's deportment, and will be furnished to parents in special cases.

Students, whose conduct or progress in study is unsatisfactory, will not be allowed to remain in the Institution.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES.

All Students are required to attend Divine Service on the Sabbath, at such Churches as their parents or guardians may prefer.

They are also required to attend daily prayers, with the reading of the Holy Scriptures, in the College Chapel.

An effort is thus made to secure a healthful moral and religious influence, but the inculcation of sectarian views will be avoided.

MISCELLANEOUS REMARKS.

Parents are *earnestly requested* not to furnish their sons with *spending money*, or at least to do so very sparingly. Compliance with this rule is of the first importance, especially in the case of younger lads.
