Forever rest, thy mirrored halo rest!

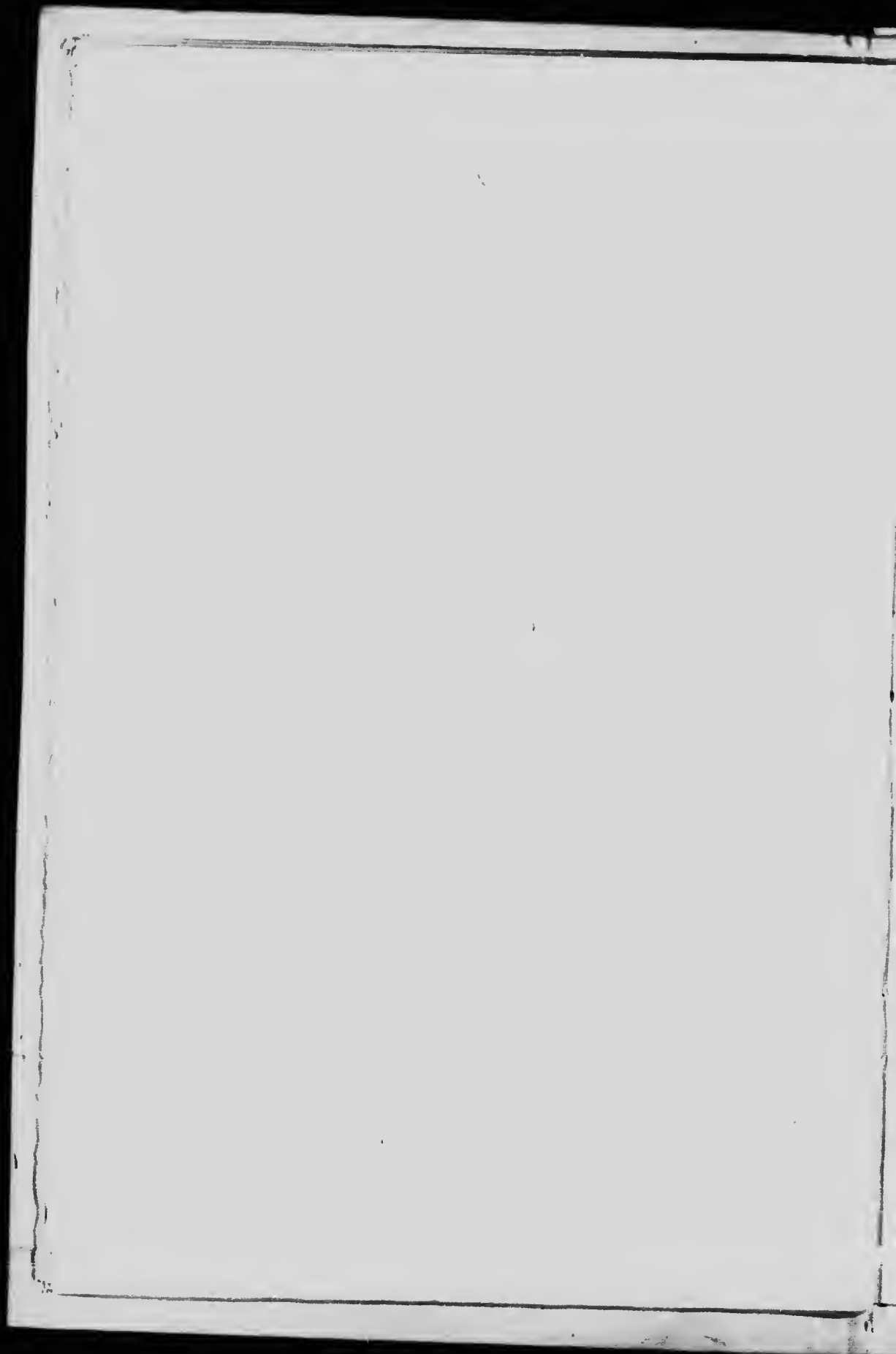
YE whispering angels, now your vigils keep,
