ANNUAL REPORT.

THE Managers of the *Niagara Annual Conference Missionary Society*, in presenting their Annual Report, would express their unfeigned gratitude to God for that watchful care with which our Missionaries have been favored during the past year; not only in the preservation of their lives, but considering their numerous hardships, their health has been tolerably good.

The Missionaries have suffered more from the money pressure, and the failure in the crops, than those in the regular work. In many places, those amongst whom they labored were without the means of support—instances might be mentioned of severe family affliction. Thus, with the money pressure, local destitution, excessive labors, severe exposure, much suffering has been endured; but none have fallen, they are still active, and evince a laudable ambition to push the battle of our Lord and of his Christ to the very gates of the enemy. The Lord speed the final triumph. Between twenty and thirty fields of labor have shared in the funds of the Society this year, engaging the labors in part or in full, of over thirty ministers, and embracing destitute portions of country, from Lake Scugog to Collingwood harbor, thence westward to St. Clair and Sandwich, supplying a destitute multitude with the bread of life. Nor have they wrought in vain, gracious prosperity has been realized, and especially on some charges, large numbers have lately exchanged a burden of guilt and gloom, for a glorious hope of eternal life. Statistical reports have been returned by most of the Missionaries, which have been on the whole, very pleasing. The following are the fields from which statements have been supplied.

Mission Fields of Niagara Conference Auxiliary.

ORANGEVILLE MISSION.

This field of labor is situated in the County of Wellington, and embraces the Township of Mono, Amaranth, Garafraxa and Caledon; it has seven regular appointments, besides occasional ones, with a membership of one hundred and forty, being an increase of thirty-seven members for the past year. There is a general complaint of hard times, resulting from the present financial pressure. We are, however, erecting a neat church on the property of Mr. James Johnson, Garafraxa, who gave a site for that purpose, as also anticipating the erection of another at Melleville. The members have nobly contributed to the support of the gospel, and are anxiously looking forward to the time when the Orangeville Mission will become self-sustaining. Brethren pray for us.

GODERICH MISSION

This Mission consists of 3 appointments. We have but one chapel, which is situated in the town of Goderich, where we preach twice each Sabbath. The other appointments are, one five and the other seven miles from Goderich. There are three classes with three regular leaders, also a proper board of stewards. The town appointment has improved materially during the past year—there is one Sabbath school in good condition. We regard this mission as a very important Station. May the "God of all grace" prosper it.

ELMA MISSION.

Elma Mission is composed of the Township of Wallace and Elma, in the County of Perth. This is a new and promising field of labor and bids fair to become in a few years a good Circuit notwithstanding the present year has been one of unusual severity, occasioned by the almost total failure of the crops in the new Townships, the friends on the Mission raised one hundred and fifty dollars towards meeting the claims of the missionary laboring among them and thirty-seven dollars sixty-three cents of missionary money. preachers one exhorter, seven stewards and four class leaders; there are eight regular appointments, two union Sabbath schools, besides three belonging to other denominations. There is an increasing interest manifested in the institutions of the Gospel in every locality; visited by our preachers.

TEESWATER MISSION.

This Mission is located in the County of Bruce, and embraces the Townships of Culross and Kinloss. It has six regular appointments, besides occasional ones, a membership of 42, with an efficient Board of Stewards. The soil is well adapted to agricultural purposes, the people have hard times at present, on account of the partial failure of crops the year past; but are generally enterprising and liberal in supporting the gospel according to their ability. There is a parsonage in the Village of Teeswater, partially finished, also a site for a chapel in the same place secured by bond. The future prospect of this work is fair, and if well cultivated will be self-sustaining at no very distant period. Brethren pray for the prosperity of Zion on this field of labor.

STANLEY MISSION.

This field of labor embraces the Townships of Stanley, Hay, Osborne, Hibbert and Tuckersmith, has nine Sabbath appointments, a membership of one hundred and ten in seven classes, four exhorters, a full board of Stewards and Leaders, two chapels—one has been built during the past year. The people have contributed to the support of their preachers, and to the Missionary Society, over two hundred dollars during the past year. The work is prosperous and the Mission bids fair to soon become self-sustaining.

Mission Fields of Bay Quinte Conference Auxiliary.

THE Board of Managers of the Bay of Quinte Auxiliary Missionary Society, in presenting their Annual Report, would acknowledge with gratitude to the Giver of all good, the success which has attended the efforts of the society to advance the cause of Christ.

Another year with its light and shade, joy and sorrow, has traced its destiny on the map of time, and left its record on high, and we cannot but congratulate our friends on the flourishing condition of our Society, at its close—success on the older charges, the opening of new fields of labor, increase of influence and interest, and the conversion of *many*, attest the Divinity of our cause. But the past year, though crowned with much success, has also witnessed many toils, privations, and sufferings, on the part of those who have gone forth on their mission of faith and labors of love, under the direction of your Board. This is partly owing to the wide extension of the work during the past year, with out a proportionate enlargement of funds. The cry has come up to us from many a desolate field, Send us the Gospel, and the men of faith have been found and sent out, trusting to the liberality of our friends and adherents. Shall it be found that that confidence has been misplaced? We expect to receive an answer, (as we ever have), in the noble, generous and extended liberality, which has ever characterized our people; we ask nothing from corrupt governments; we put not our trust in princes, we confide in the large-heartedness and christian zeal of an enlightened people, and we have *never yet* been disappointed. You will hear from us concerning the state of the work. Commencing at LaChute a chain of Mission Stations run upwards along the Ottawa, and skirting the out-post of civilization in the rear of the older settlements, extends westward to Lake Superior. Under the especial charge of the Bay Quinte Auxiliary, there are 18 Mission appointments, as follows:—

SEYMORE.

This Mission embraces part of the township of Seymour, Pe
Asphodel and Dummel. There are ten appointments, and many
more could be taken up had we men and means. The cry from
many parts is, Come over and help us. The work on Seymour
Mission is progressing.

MARMORA

Includes the Village and Township of Marmora—two appoint-
ments—congregations large and intelligent—a few members.
Here the cause is looking up.

ELZIVER.

Br. Hill writes, this Mission embraces the Township of Madoc,
Elziver and Tudor. There are five appointments on the Mission,
and a membership of forty-five. The people are poor, still they
want the Gospel, and in some parts appear to be willing to do what
they can in sustaining it.

HUNGERFORD.

Of this charge, the Missionary, P. Empey, reports as follows:
—“ Hungerford Mission, where I have been the past year, is an ex-
tensive field of labor, embracing not only the Township of Hun-
gerford, but extending to other Townships as far as the head of
Mashanog Lake. To meet the appointments on this Mission, we
have to travel about one hundred and eighty miles every month.
There are fifteen standing appointments, seven Stewards, one Ex-
horter, eight leaders, and one hundred and ninety-four members
now upon this charge. The brethren on the Mission are warmly
attached to our *Church and her institutions*. Everything considered,
we feel in duty bound to say that our friends here have done well,
by way of support, having raised in all, fifty-eight pounds seven-
teen shillings, for the support of the Gospel, and I have no doubt, this
field ere long will become a self sustaining Circuit.

KENEBECK.

This Mission lies in the County of Frontenac, embracing the
Township of Kenebec and Olden, about fifty miles north of Kings-
ton. This is the second year that it has been occupied. There are
seventy-one members, a board of seven Stewards, three Exhorters,
&c., six Leaders. They have paid their Preacher \$43 42. There

are six standing appointments. The country is new and the people are poor, yet that old and indefatigable pioneer Missionary, I. N. D. West, who labored on this charge during the past year, says he thinks, that in a very few years, it will become self-sustaining.

VANKLEEKHILL.

In reporting the work on this Mission, there is much of a discouraging nature to submit. The opposition, open and covert, of enemies, the unfaithfulness of seeming friends, and circumstances of the past, over which we have had no control, have during the past year, cast their shadows over our beloved Zion, and almost paralyzed our efforts. But there is much to encourage—*God has been with us.* Some have been turned from sin to serve *God* in newness of life. Our friends though few, are whole-hearted and faithful, and wait expectingly, the coming shadows of grace and salvation. We have at present four appointments, thirty-five members and seven probationers. May the *God* of all grace send prosperity.

RICEVILLE MISSION.

This Mission is situated in the County of Prescott, fifty miles east of *Ottawa City*, along the Nation River, including parts of the Townships of North and South Plantagenet, Caledonia, Cambridge and Roxborough. There are seven appointments and thirty-eight members, divided in into three classes. There is a comfortable parsonage at Riceville, and prospects are good.

STORMONT MISSION

Is composed of parts of the Township of Osnabruck, Cornwall, Roxburgh and Williamsburgh. This Mission has suffered considerably this year from various causes, yet on the whole, we have no reason to complain. The *Lord* has seen fit to revive His work, and sinners have been converted. We have received thirty-four on probation during the last six months. The brethren have built a chapel and parsonage house. We have 12 appointments and 8 classes. Our membership is 125, and we expect by the grace of *God*, ere long, *Stormont* will take its place on the list of respectable Circuits. May the *Good Lord* pour out *His Spirit* on this Mission, and may hundreds be brought into the fold of *Christ*.

PITTSBURGH

Mission extends some 30 miles along the St. Lawrence, between Kingston and Brockville. There are 12 Sabbath and 4 evening appointments, 11 classes, 3 Sabbath schools, 166 members. Its

situation is in a rough and partially barren part of the country. The people are poor, and the prospect is they will remain so. An efficient laborer is required to insure success.

HINCHINBROOK

Lies in the Townships of Hinchinbrook, Portland and Bedford. The country—new—poor, and the people more or less addicted to drinking; but by the labors of the Missionary, Rev. J. Graham, with the efforts of some of our friends, a good influence has been exerted, a lodge of Templars formed, and prosperity attends our labors. Membership 140, Sabbath schools 4. The prospects are indeed flattering.

LEEDS

Embraces the Township of Leeds, Lansdown and Storrington. Toil and privation have been endured, but God has been present, and our cause is prosperous. Appointments 9, members 131, about 50 of whom have been added during the past year. The people are poor, and are almost entirely dependent upon our Missionary for religious instruction.

EGANVILLE

Is situated in the County of Renfrew, on Bonna Cheur river. The people are chiefly emigrants from the Old Country, and were deeply prejudiced against Methodism; but those prejudices are fast wearing away, and gospel light beginning to dawn, and souls have been brought to God. There are 12 appointments, 75 members, 3 class-leaders, 1 exhorter, 1 local preacher. The people are generally poor, but very kind, and have done all they could to support the Missionary.

MADAWASKA

Is situated in the Townships of McNab, Packenham and Baggot, on the Madawaska river. The greatest part of the people are nominally Episcopalian or Presbyterian, but are quite favorable to the Methodist Church. Congregations large and respectable. The Missionary, H. Seymour, writes, "I have no doubt if the work be faithfully followed up, the little church placed on the Madawaska, will increase in numbers, piety and usefulness."

RENFREW

Embraces the villages of Renfrew and Arnprior, with the adjacent county, and contains 5 appointments and 38 members, with favor-

able prospects of extension. The Missionary, J. H. Rombough, writes, "this portion of our work is of importance to our Church. Let us enter into the field already white to the harvest."

WESTMEATH

Lies westward from Ottawa City, about 80 miles on the Ottawa river—11 appointments, 125 members. There is a comfortable parsonage, partly furnished with heavy furniture, a quarter of an acre of land, &c., in the pleasant village of Beachburgh. The P. C., *C. W. Lent*, writes, "On the whole, Westmeath Mission, in my opinion, is an encouraging field of labor, and the probability is, in a short time it will be able to sustain itself, and not only stand alone, but assist the weak. May God bless *His* beloved people, and build up, prosper, and establish *His* church. Amen."

TEMPLETON.

This Mission is situated in the Township of Templeton and Hull, in the County of Ottawa. There are 3 appointments, and 40 members, 2 class-leaders and 1 exhorter. We have had some discouragement. The loss of one church by fire, and the failure in the crops, have left the members in embarrassing circumstances. Yet they *are striving to do the best they can*.

TARBOLTON.

From this Mission, Bro. *L. A. Betts* reports, "This Mission requires 106 miles travel every fortnight, roads very bad, people very poor, the country thinly settled, and agricultural prospects anything but prosperous; the people are almost inaccessible to the Methodist. During the past year I have preached 108 sermons, held 10 prayer-meetings, visited and prayed with 83 families, and travelled 1580 miles. I report no *increase*, and would recommend the abandonment of the field."

And now in reporting the past permit us to glance into the future. We have said our work extends from LaChute to Lake Superior; but the field is widening, Red River, Asiniboin and British Columbia are open for the Gospel. The far-west lies before us, shall it be occupied? Give us your prayers and money, *our God* will furnish us the men of faith and love, and the "wilderness and solitary place will become glad, and the *desert will rejoice*, and blossom as the rose."

RESOLUTIONS OF THE PARENT SOCIETY.

RESOLVED,—That the preachers having charge of Missions shall report to the Secretary of the Parent Missionary Society at Hamilton, a full account of their field of labor, once a quarter, including the extent of travel, number of appointments and officers, with the progress made, and prospects. And that Presiding Elders on Districts having Missions in charge, shall furnish a full account of all their work in their Districts, at least once in six months. And all claimants on the funds failing to comply, may forfeit their claims thereby.

The following were added by the Board, at its meeting in Hamilton, April 29th, 1859 :

1st. That each Missionary shall, in addition to his Quarterly Reports, furnish to Secretary of the Auxiliary Society at the Conference, a summary of the state of his work.

2nd. That we regard the appropriation of Missionary money to any other purpose, than that for which it was contributed, as a breach of trust; and as such, must subject the persons making such misappropriations, to be dealt with according to the Discipline of the Church. And we request the Auxiliary Society, strictly to attend to this matter, within their respective bounds.
