Valuable Discoveries of Iron in the Vermilion Range.
DELTON, July 17.—Valuable discoveries of iron have been made by Dutch explorers on the north branch of the Vermilion range, on the Canadian side of the line, and considerable quantities of iron ore have been discovered. Samples taken from the surface of the ledge show about 50 per cent. metallic iron, which is certainly a first-class ore. Whether this contains much phosphorus has not yet been determined, but it is believed to be rich enough for careful examination to indicate the Dutch discoverers to purchase 500 acres of more land along the Vermilion range. The little exploration done so far shows up a wide vein and a long one which undoubtedly grows richer as shafts are sunk into it. The continuation eastward of the northern branch of the Vermilion vein into Canada has long been known by explorers, though previous to this find but little work has been done there.
