S., was damaged to the extent of \$11,000 on the 4th inst. - The wing of the public school at Preston. Ont., was totally destroyed by fire on Monday Inst.-On Thursday last the following buildings at Perth, Ont., were destroyed by fire: The Star printing office, with all new machinery, loss \$5,000, insurance \$3,600; M. R. Dodds' flour and pork store, loss about \$1,000, small insurance. Barrie block, occupied by Barrie Bros., butchers, insurance \$3,000; the Douglas block, occupied by Henry Taylor, hardware, loss \$20,000.-A destructive fire occurred at Point du Chene, near Shediac, N. B., on the 6th inst. Two summer hotels known as Point du Chene house and the Seaside hotel we'e destroyed, together with the dwelling and store owned by Miss Keith, a house, store and harn owned by George McDonald, and four other houses owned by M. Harney, Wm. Smith, Andrew Simpson and George Harper respectively. The Du Chene house was owned by George L. Hanington, and the other by Mrs. James McDonald. The value of the buildings destroyed is said to be \$15,000 to \$20,000. Insurance \$6.000. - The Dominion Mills at London, Ont., were damaged by fire to the extent of \$1,500 on the 8th inst.—On the night of the 7th inst. the following haildings were destroyed by fire at Lethbridge, Man., Lawrence's furniture store, the Royal hotel, Dentoris' residence and Macdonald's store. The premises of Little & Cleveland, Carter & Lowther and Haw ley & Co. were also damaged. Total loss, \$50,-000, of which MacDonald & Co. lese \$40,000.

A good putty or mastic suitable for decorators use may be prepared, according to Cosmos, by taking nine parts of well-dried clay that has previously been purified; this is mixed with one part of litharge, and then enough linseed oil is added to the mixture in order to bring it to the consistency of wet plaster. Be-fore applying this mastic, the surfaces that are to be joined should be thoroughly moistened with a sponge; this is particu-larly necessary in the case of stone or brickwork. The mixture takes about five or six days before it is completely hardened, but it possesses great properties of adherence and durability.
