SACKVILLE, N. B., AUGUST 29, 1889.

In Charlotte County, a company of western men have purchased a beautiful stretch of the beach near New River with the intention of using it as a sea bathing resort. It is rumored that the mineral springs of Pennfield will also be bought by a syndicate, and fitted up as a watering place.

American sealing schooner, James G. Swan was seized in Behring Sea July 30, with 235 dead seals aboard by the government revenue cutter Kosh. The vessel's documents and skins were taken aboard the Kosh, and she was ordered to Sitka, Alaska, but proceeded to Port Townsend and surrendered to the collector of customs. There are between 40 and 50 vessels now in Behring Sea. The seals, with 600 skins, July 31st. The seizure of the Pathfinder and Minnie was confirmed. The Pathfinder was the only vessel placed in charge of an American officer, excepting the Black Diamond.

The London Times says: "There is a curious war of seriousness about the Behring sea seizures. It appears they are intended to frighten away Victorian sealers by sham formalities of capture and not to exact the usual penalties. America appears to think this course will appease the Alaska company and please the Irish electors, yet not provoke British reprisals. But she has no right to play a game of 'bounce' with the weapons of illegal capture and search. Unless England takes some active step America will be perfectly content with an interchange of view till doomsday. Americans will not find us unreasonable on the score of preserving seals from extinction. If they persist in refusing to discuss any settlement our only course is to take vigorous steps to see that our rights are respected."

The following sensible observations are from the Providence Evening Bulletin: "It is possibly still true that 'Canada has nothing that our New England fishermen want,' and that 'they would be a good deal better off if they never put into Canadian waters'; but the fact that the number of licenses issued to American fishermen under the modus vivendi is this year twice as great as last summer is pretty good evidence that some fishermen, at least, not only do want something in Canada but are willing to pay well for it. It cannot have escaped notice, moreover, that this much-abused modus vivendi has given us two seasons of peace in place of the previous years of contention. But the arrangement ends this year, and it would be interesting to know if the present Administration, which report says, has taken no steps toward a final settlement of the question, will endeavour to secure a temporary extension of the present agreement, or will prefer to see a return of the old harassing and dangerous conditions."

Our cousins over the border are not making very rapid progress in creating a navy. It is true that Congress has made a large appropriation for the purpose, but the vote was hampered by limitations which render it practically worthless. Tenders have recently been invited by the naval department for the construction of five steel cruisers, three of which were each to be of 2,000 tons displacement and the other two of 3,000 each. The vessels were to be completed in two years, and the cost of the smallest ones was not to exceed \$700,000 each, while the larger ones were to cost \$1,000,000 each. The proposals were opened last week and none of the tenders were as low as the limit. The bids for the smaller vessels ranged from \$789,000 to \$875,000 and the only tender for the larger vessels was for \$1,225,000 each. The lowest tender for the smaller vessels was coupled with the condition that the advertised time should be extended. It is probable that Congress will limit the next session to increase the limit of cost, but in the meantime the great United States navy remains unbuild.

The work of disintegration has already commenced in the Equal Rights Association of Ontario, an institution which owes its existence to opposition to the Jesuit Estates bill. Mr. Bradbury, secretary of the Ottawa Branch, has resigned on the ground that the efforts of the Association are being directed exclusively against the Dominion Government, while, in his opinion, the first object of attack should be the Ontario Administration. Mr. Bradbury is evidently a friend of the Dominion Government, and his party feelings are proved by his action in this matter to be stronger than his zeal for the professed objects of the Association. Many other members of the organization have undoubtedly joined it in the hope that it will be the instrument of defeat of the Dominion Ministry, and they find that it is likely to be an injury to Mr. Mowat, they will be ready, like Mr. Bradbury, to leave its ranks. In fact, the Association appears to be composed of incongruous materials, and the Equal Rights agitation is not strong enough to prove a permanent bond of union. The majority of its members are desirous of using the Equal Rights movement for the furtherance of their party views, and if they find the results are likely to be contrary to their anticipations they will be pretty certain to stick to their party and let equal rights take care of themselves. The attempt to instigate a war of race and religion for party purposes has not awakened much sympathy in the Maritime Provinces, and the inevitable collapse of the Equal Rights Association will not occasion much regret.

PERSONAL AND POLITICAL.

It is asserted that preparations are being made for the Pope's departure from Rome.

William Reuben Wentzel sub-collector of Customs at Lunenburg, has absconded. His accounts show a shortage of about \$2,000. He had been in the customs service about ten years, and his salary was \$400 per annum.

Rev. Charles S. Medley, Canon of Christ's Church Cathedral, Fredericton, and Rector of Trinity Church Sussex, died at the latter place last Sunday evening, aged 54 years. He is a son of the venerable Metropolitan of Canada and was highly esteemed by all who knew him. He has been ill for some months.

A Chicago despatch of the 26th inst., is as follows:—Burke Wood, last committed to trial, the jury having brought in a verdict to the effect that the persons named had guilty knowledge of the manner in which the poison got into Hicks' dinner-pail.

An Italian savant, Dr. Malincoico of Naples, pretends to have discovered something better yet than the elixir of Prof. Brown-Sequard. He has just discovered the microbe of old age, and he is now engaged in thinking about the best way to kill him. When one thinks of the length of time that this honey-headed old microbe has been in concealment, the value of Dr. Malincoico's discovery can be easily appreciated.—New York Sun.

Baptist Convention.

The annual convention of the Baptists of the Maritime Provinces met at Fredericton last Saturday, about 300 delegates being present. The convention was established in 1846, and its yearly meetings have alternated between New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, except in 1887, when the meeting was held at Charlottetown. The officers elected for the ensuing year are as follows:—President—E. D. King, M. A., Halifax. Vice President—W. Sparden, Fredericton. Second Vice President—Rev. J. A. Gordon, Charlottetown. Secretary—Rev. Prof. Kierstead, Acadia. Recording Secretary—Rev. G. R. White, Amherst. Treasurer—W. G. Clark, Fredericton. By nomination of the board of governors the following gentlemen were elected fellows of Acadia college: Rev. W. H. Warren, M. A., for two years, and Rev. E. M. A. R. for two years, and Rev. M. A. Q. C. and Rev. B. B. Kempton, M. A., for nine years.

The Convention closed its labors on Tuesday, having first decided to meet at Yarmouth next year. A despatch from London, Eng., says that the Canada Northwest Coal and Lumber syndicate has been registered with a capital of \$700,000, in order to purchase and work the Coal Creek and Bow River mines and other property near Calgary. Lord Norbury, Viscount Grimston, M. P., and George Baden-Powell, M. P., are among the first subscribers. The Anglo-Canadian Asbestos company has also been registered, with a capital of £200,000, to carry out an agreement between the Anglo-Canadian Asbestos company, in liquidation, and W. H. Brown, in connection with the work asbestos properties in Canada.

Two more iron and steel steamer companies are being added to the regular commercial fleet of Halifax. The new steamer Brigewater, to ply between Halifax and the Labare River, is now on her way out from Scotland, and the steamer Glasgow has been purchased to run between Halifax, St. John's Nfld., and Boston. Another steamer is projected to run between Halifax, Chester and Mahone Bay, the necessary capital having been subscribed.

There were 4,000 passengers from Boston to Halifax by steamer alone during May, June, July, and only about 2,000 from Halifax to Boston. As a natural consequence the Grip press has had nothing to say about the statistics for some time past, but when the American visitors begin to return home the statistics of travel will be quoted to show that the country is being depopulated under Tory rule.

According to the Colonist of the 17th, the salmon pack of British Columbia to date amounts to a total of 376,000 cases, being 127,000 above the largest pack of any previous year. It is estimated that the year's pack will reach 420,000 cases. This has all been sold from \$5.50 to \$6.50, and, calculating at \$6.00 per case, makes a total of over two million and a half dollars.

The famous Messer beach at Cow Bay, near Halifax, is bonded to an American syndicate for \$20,000. There are upwards of 900 acres on the beach and property, and if properly fitted up it will become one of the most famous resorts in Canada, if not on the continent.

The schooner Sapphire arrived at Victoria, B. C., a few days ago, with 1,000 seal skins on board. The Sapphire was chased five hours by the U. S. cutter Rash, but managed to outlast her. The annual competition of the Nova Scotia Rifle association took place at Bedford last week. The annual meeting of the New Brunswick association commenced at Sussex on Tuesday. The preliminary survey of the Harvey-Salisbury line has been completed.

Crop Report.

Nova Scotia's gold yield for the six months ending 30th of June is 13,628oz and 11dwts, valued at \$245,222.90. The royalty to the government would be \$490,446.

The brig, Hattie Louise, in command of Capt. McKee, sailed from Summerside on Friday last for the West Indies. Her cargo consists of 18,000 bushels of oats, 16 horses, and 100 sheep.

A Montreal paper, of a recent date says: "Very unfavorable reports are being sent in as to the safety of the potato crop, and as a consequence prices have advanced considerably in this market during the week."

The potato crop in Yarmouth Co. is almost a total failure. The damage from rotting is reported as general in all sections of the County. We have similar accounts from other counties, and the failure of the crop will be seriously felt.

A new branch of agricultural industry is about to be started in Prince Edward Island, the production of peat moss. This article, heretofore considered worthless, is discovered to possess properties which make it the best bedding for horse's stables known.

Word comes in from some parts of P. E. Island that much of the wheat and oat crop is being cut down and hauled into the barnyards for manure. A blight has seized much of the wheat and the rest has spoiled much of the oats so that the prospects are that with many of the farmers poor crops will rule this fall.

The Summerside Agriculturist says:—The grain crop west is looking fine, scarcely any rust being noticeable. Wheat in particular is well filled. At Campbellton, Lot 7, and other places in that section, it is excellent, and the harvest is as well advanced as it is anywhere east, a good deal of grain having already been secured.

Horse Notes.

Nutbourne, trial 2.26 1/2, owned by Robt. Bonner, died last week. He was by Belmont, sire of Wedgewood 2.19, and 20 others in the 30 list, dam Miss Russell. Nutbourne was full brother to Nutwood 2.18 1/2. He sired Mr. Lamy's Col. Willows, and cost Mr. Bonner \$7,000. He was valued at \$10,000.

John LeBlanc, of Minudie, had the leg of a valuable horse broken quite recently. The animal had afterwards to be sent to Halifax. Chitwood 5.21 1/2, half brother to Sir Nutwood 5.78, has been sold to parties in Omaha for \$10,000.

The pacer Joe Howe, raised in Nova Scotia, and now owned by H. J. Tibbets, Rockport, Maine, has paced two heats in 2.25 and 2.27. Axtel trotted to beat his record of 2.14 1/2 in Chicago and made the mile in 2.14. He was sired by William L, he by Geo. Wilkes, dam Lou, by Mambrine Patchen, Axtel was foaled in 1886. He is a light brown with black points, stands 15 1/2 hands high and weighs 1,050 pounds. His owner, C. W. Williams, has only been in the business of breeding trotters three years and Axtel was one of his first crop of colts.

The strike begun by the London dock laborers and which subsequently spread to the car men has extended to the Thames iron workers, and the gas stokers threaten to join forces with the strikers. There is also talk of compelling laborers in all the trades to quit work and force matters to an issue at once. The iron workers strike adds 7,000 to the number unemployed. The shipping business is completely paralyzed and the mail steamers are leaving without cargoes. Four of the smallest vessels in the fleet have been shut down owing to the dulness of the trade. The strikers now number 130,000. The coal porters at important centres are joining the strikers. Two hundred and fifty steamers are lying in the docks awaiting orders. The Riverside factories, employing thousands of hands, are closing for lack of coal. The committee of strikers decline to allow even perishable articles to be unloaded. Coal is double the usual price. All produce is advancing. Flouring factories are stopping for want of flour. Thousands of tons of nut-rice are rotting. It is impossible to find men to handle stock.

The conclusion which a Grip organ has come to is this: "There is much in the Jesuit question which indicates that some people can strain at a gnat and swallow a camel." There is a profound truth here. The two Toronto Grip organs are calling aloud for vengeance upon the Dominion Government, and leading Grip are stamping about making the same demand because the Government could not constitutionally interfere with a Grip Jesuit, but the endorsement of Jesuits, through the bishop of their diocese, in this province by Mr. Mowat, is swallowed as meekly as possible.—Empire.

An unofficial rumor has reached the state department at Washington to the effect that the sealer Black Diamond, the first vessel seized this year, is owned in a large degree, if not entirely, by citizens of the United States. This information came to the department incidentally, while inquiry was being made into a statement that the United States vice consul at Victoria is interested largely in some colonial vessels illegally sealing in Behring Sea. The statement, so far, has not been officially confirmed.

The total original cost of the British war ships of all sorts at the last Spithead review, paraded for the inspection of the emperor, was \$18,553,765. The number of ships present was 73, of 707,000 tons. The weight of metal contained \$809 tons. The tonnage was approximately 390,000 tons. Five hundred and sixty-nine heavy guns, irreplaceable of the quick firing and machine guns, composed the armament.
