The attention of Owners and Masters of British Ships is called to the 74th ,Section of the 74.- (1) A Ship belonging to a British sub-
ject shall hoist the proper national colours-
(a) on a signal being made to her by one of
His Majesty's ships (including any vessel under the command of an officer of His Majesty's navy on full pay), and
(b) on entering or leaving any foreign port,
(c) if of fifty tons gross tonnage or upwards, (2) If default is made on board any such ship in complying with this section, the master fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.
At this time of war it is necessary for every
British Ship to hoist the colours and heave to if signalled by a British Warship; if a vessel hoists no colours and runs away, it is liable to be fired
upon. upon
