New York, July 10.—The Indian outbreak in Kansas proves to be of a serious character. Reports of fighting, murders and other outrages are numerous, and there is a panic among the settlers, who are fleeing in great numbers across the border.

New York, July 10, p. m.—A large fire at Weehawken, N. J., last night in the Erie Oil Works, caused by lightning striking an oil tank, about 7 o'clock, which contained 15,000 barrels, and the flames were blown upward to the height, as bystanders say, of 300 feet. The flames had gained such headway in the combustible material that one tank after another had to be abandoned by the firemen, who were utterly powerless to arrest the progress of the fire. Five large tanks containing 15,000 barrels each, and another containing 20,000, were burned. There was little hope at the latest accounts of saving any of the oil on storage. The same oil works were struck by lightning a few years ago, but the fire was extinguished without much damage. One hundred and twenty-five men are thrown out of employment by the fire. Loss, \$800,000—mostly insured.

Owing to the lack of employment and low rate of storage passage on steamships, a heavy exodus of working men and laborers has commenced. The outgoing steamers for Europe to-day leave with their steerages crammed, and tickets have been sold for several weeks ahead.
