IT WAS THE ADMIRAL'S FAULT!

CAUSE OF THE LOSS OF THE VICTORIA MADE CLEAR.

And the Order Signalled Been Fully Executed Every Pair of Ships in the Fleet Would Have Collided. The Story of the Disaster Told by Rear-Admiral Markham.

LONDON, July 2.—A special despatch received at Plymouth from Malta confirms the cause of the disaster. It is clear beyond controversy that if the order signalled from the Victoria had been fully executed every pair of ships in the fleet would have come into collision. The other vessels, however, observed what would happen in time to prevent disaster to the whole squadron.

Rear-Admiral Markham's Despatches.

LONDON, July 2.—The despatches received at Malta from Rear-Admiral Markham's headquarters concerning the collision of the Victoria and the Camperdown are published in full. The first despatch was dated from the Victoria on June 22. It says: "I have with profound regret that I have to report the total loss of H.M.S. Victoria, involving the irreparable loss of the Commander in Chief, Vice-Admiral Sir George Tryon, 22 officers and 338 men, under the following circumstances:

The squadron, consisting of H.M.S. Victoria, Camperdown, Nile, Dreadnought, Indefatigable, Collingwood, Phaeton, Edinburgh, Southampton, Edgar, Amphion, Fearless and Barham, left Beyer's boat at 10.15 for the purpose of Tripoli. Shortly after the squadron formed into single column line ahead and proceeded at the rate of about eight knots an hour. When about five miles from the anchorage off Tripoli, the signal was given at 2.30 in the afternoon to form columns of divisions in line ahead, disposed as beam to front, with the Victoria in the center, the Nile to the right and the Camperdown to the left. We proceeded in this formation until 2.28, when the signal was made from the Victoria to the Nile to turn 10 points to port and to the second division to turn 10 points to starboard. The Nile obeyed the signal, but the Camperdown, being in the rear, did not see the signal and did not turn.
