CHINA MAKING FRANTIC EFFORTS TO SECURE A LOAN.

n Attack on the Fortifications at Web Hai-Wei Expected Hourly-Japanese Taking Every Precaution Preparatory to An Advance-A Big Battle on the

Yalu Reported. London, Oct. 18.—The Shanghai correspondent of the Central News says that the Chinese Government is making great efforts to raise a domestic loan, offering seven per cent. interest. Several mil-

ions have been taken already. The work on the fortifications at Weiselmai-Wei is pressed forward with feversish haste. The old forts have been strengthened, new ones are going up, and all the weaker points are being covered with earthwork. Troops are concentrating there rapidly, but many of them are indifferently equipped. The garrison is thoroughly alarmed for the safety of the port, and sensational rumors as to an approaching attack are set afloat almost daily. The commander has good reason to expect a sudden attack from the Japanese soon.

A rebellion has broken out in the district round Foo Chow, and peaceable persons are coming into the city by handreds. The fear of a Japanese attack has increased recently, and more torped does and mines have been laid in the bed of the Min. The river has been so carefully fortified that navigation has become dangerous.

London, Oct. 13.—The Times corress pondent in Tien-Tsin says Japanese newsepapers now received afford negative evidence that the report three weeks ago of the despatch of an army corps to Hiroshima was intended to be a bluff, such a movement being impossible in consequence of the shattered condition of the Japanese fleet. Moreover, Japan perhaps is beginning to reflect on the problem of the eventual extrication of her troops from Corea, where they remain on the sufferance of the maritime powers, especially Russia. The latter is sending eleven additional ships, including "three ironclads, and will have the most formidable fleet ever assembled east of the Suez Canal.

A despatch to The Globe from Port Arthur, under date of Oct. 16, says the Japanese have abandoned Thornton Haven and advanced to Ping Yang Inlet, which they are strongly fortifying. It is reported in native circles that a great battle was fought north of the Yalu River on Oct. 15, but no details are given. The Chinese officials deny any knowledge of the reported fight.
