#### MARKET AND GENERAL REPORT.

Trade almost in every branch may be said to have received a temporary check through the impediment to the transit of goods into the interior by the ice on the Fraser river. Sales have therefore been very limited and chiefly local. Successful efforts are being made by the Chamber of Commerce to disseminate correct information regarding the advantages of the British Columbian route to the new gold diggings over that of the Oregon or Portland.

The Big Bend, unlike most other gold diggings, seems to inspire almost universal confidence, and each successive account from the locality corroborates all preceding ones. Although rather too early in the season a good number have already started for the El Dorado. Doubtless a large population will be attracted before the close of the coming season. These mines have the advantage of being within a short distance of good stock and farming country, and prices of provisions will keep at figures admitting of men with very limited means prospecting and trying their luck on new ground. The navigation of the Fraser river is expected to be open in a few days—the only barrier being at Union Bar; the difficulty is however being removed by a gang of men employed for that purpose.

As the spring opens there is every probability of a brisk business being done, and the prospects of the country generally seem to be based on a more substantial foundation than previous years.

**ALES**—Good brands are held firm, but Colonial brewing having much improved is interfering with the sale.

**BOOTS and SHOES**—(Eng<sup>l</sup>ish) manufactured to suit the market, in good demand at prices leaving a fair margin.

**BEANS**—Seem to have an upward tendency, and are held for higher prices, having advanced also in California.

**CLOTHING**—Market rather overstocked, prices low.

**COFFEE**—Very limited supplies; only small quantity in importers hands; slight advance in price.

**DRY GOODS**—Market healthy, stocks in proportion only to demand.

**FLOUR**—No extensive sales; quotations will doubtless be sustained, as the San Francisco market shows a slight advance. Fair stocks on hand and per cent arrivals and expected per W. A. Banks and W. D. Rice there will be an addition to them of 10,194 qr sacks.

**GRAIN**—Market dull, sales only local.

**IRON**—English Pig, none offered for sale, all bought up for the California market, where prices has greatly advanced.

**LIQUORS**—Large stocks of Brandy; a good many forced sales have brought prices low; other liquors moderate supplies.

**CILMAN'S STORES**—Large quantities of inferior brands on hand; prices low but with tendency to rise.

**RICE**—About 5,000 mats on hand and on the way; prices steady.

**TEA**—Stocks low, but no advance in price.

**WINES**—Large stocks and prices nominal.
