

ANACT

TO LAY AND COLLECT A DUTY UPON STILLS.

HERMAS, for the better support of the Government of this Province, it is expedient to increase the Revenues thereof; We Your Majesty's most dutiful and Loyal Subjects, the Representatives of the People of the Province of Upper Canada, in Attempty met, do most humbly befeech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeat " certain parts of an Act passed in the sourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, in-" tituled; "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of ** the Province of Quebec; in North America, and to make further provision for " the Government of the faid Province," and by the authority of the fame, That Duty to be paid from and after the fifth day of April next, there that be raifed, levied, collected for every galloo and paid yearly, and every year, unto His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, to which a still, in and for the ule of this Province, and towards the support of the Civil Government of containing. thereof, of and from all persons having and using a Still or Stills, or hereafter to have and use a Still or Stills, for the purpose of Distilling Spirituous Liquors for fale, a fum not exceeding one shilling and three-pence, lawful money of this Province, for every gallon which the body of fuch Still or Stills shall or may be capable of containing, in manner herein after mentioned.

II. And whereas it is expedient to make provision for the fervice of the current Provision to year, Be it enacted by the authority aforelaid. That the faid Duties shall begin and the current be payable for the feven months, which will elapse between the fifth day of Sep-year, to detertember, and the fifth day of April next ensuing the passing of this AA, to be paid. at and after the rate of seven-pence half-penny, lawful money as aforesaid, per gallon, in manner herein after mentioned.

III. And in order that the fize of the feveral Stills to be employed for the pur- Method of al. poses aforesaid, may be more truly ascertained, and the Duties to be imposed certaining the thereon more easily collected, Be it enacted by the authority asoresaid, That from able stills, and after the fifth day of November next, it shall not be lawful for any person to make use of any Still or Stills, for Distilling Spirituous Liquors for fale, until he shall have obtained a Licence for that purpose; and every person desirous of obtaining fuch a Licence, shall, in a written requisition for the lame, to be made in manner hereafter mentioned, specify and fet forth the number of gallons which the body of the Still or Stills he proposes to use, does or do contain, which specification shall be inserted in the Licence to him to be granted; And in case any person shall make use of any Still for the purpose of Distilling Spirits for sale, using or having without having obtained such Licence, or shall make use of any Still or Stills for in a situation to the purpose of Distilling Spirits, of larger dimensions than that or those specified of larger dimensions than that or those specified of larger dimensions than that or those specified of larger dimensions than the still or Stills erections than specified in the specified of the purpose of the stills are still or Stills erections. ed or fet up over a Furnace or Fire-place, so as the same may be used for Distilling, eisied in the li-capable of containing singly or together a greater number of gallons in the body or bodies thereof, than the number of gallons specified and set forth in his Licence

or requisition, and be thereof lawfully convicted by confession, or on the oath of one credible witness, before any of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, he shall forseit and pay for every such offence the sum of ten pounds, lawful money as aforelaid, to be levied by distress and sale of the offenders goods and chattels, one half of which said sum of ten pounds shall be given to the person or persona informing, and the other half paid into the hands of His Majesty's Receiver General, to and for the public uses of this Province; and that the Still or Stills so employed shall be forseited to His Majesty, and that the party having used the same, shall be incapable of obtaining a Licence for the purpose of Distilling Spirituous Liquors for sale, for and during the term of three years.

Licences to be iffued by the Secretary.

IV. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That the Secretary of the Province for the time being, shall and may by himself and Agents for that purpose to be duly appointed in each and every District of this Province, issue all Licences for the purposes above mentioned, upon such requisition as aforesaid, which may be in the following form:

Form of requifition for such licences.

Such requifitions to be filed, a copies thereof granted, when required. V. And be it further Enalled, That every such requisition, signed by the party as aforesaid, shall be carefully filed and preserved by the said Secretary, or his respective Agent duly appointed, (which appointment shall by the said Secretary be publicly notified in the Upper Canada Gazette) and the said Secretary and each of his said Agents shall, upon application to any of them that purpose made, grant to every person desiring the same, a true copy of any such requisition filed in his office, on payment of one shilling by the party applying for the same, which copy shall be signed by the said Secretary or his Agent, and shall be held and taken as lawful evidence of such requisition or Licence, for all purposes whatever.

VI. And be it further Enasted by the Authority aforefaid, That all persons desirous of obtaining such Licence as aforesaid, shall make such application as herein before is set forth, so that they may be supplied with the same, on or before the sisted where to apply for such purpose; the Secretary of the Province shall and is hered where to apply for such purpose; the Secretary of the Province shall and is hered where to give notice in the Upper Canada Gazette, or otherwise, at least six weeks next before the said fifth day of September, and hereaster yearly and every year at least one month before the fifth day of April, setting forth at what place and by whom such Licences are to be issued in every District in this Province; and also the penalties to be incurred by such persons as shall resulte or neglect to comply with the provisions herein contained, and the said Secretary, and his Agents in their respective District, shall upon such requisition as aforesaid, make out and deliver to every person applying for the same, upon payment of the sum of seven-pence half-penny per gallon as herein before mentioned, a Licence for the purpose of Distilling Spirituous Liquors for a period of seven months, which shall expire on the fisth day of April next.

VII. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That all Licences to be Duty for every granted for the purposes aforesaid, after the said fifth day of April next, shall be dated on the fixth day of April in the year in which they are issued, and shall expire on the fifth day of April next enfuing the date thereof, and that it shall and may be lawful for the faid Secretary or his Agents to demand and receive from every person requiring such Licence, the sum of one shilling and three-pence for every gallon which the body of the Still or Stills fo Licenced shall be capable of containing according to the specification in the faid Licence contained.

VIII. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That it shall and may be lawful for the faid Secretary and each of his Agents severally, to demand and take the fum of two shillings and fix-pence, and no more, as his fee upon the issuing of every such Licence as aforesaid.

1X. And be it further Enacted by the Authority sforefaid, That it shall not be lawful for the faid Secretary or any of his Agents, to grant a Licence for the working of left than 10gal any Still, unless the body thereof be capable of containing at least ten gallons lons, not to be wine measure, and if any person shall use a Still for the Distilling of Spirituous tist spirite for Liquors for fale, the body of which is not capable of containing ten gallons, and fale. be thereof lawfully convicted, by confession, or by the oath of one credible witness, before any one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, he shall forseit and pay for every such offence the sum of ten pounds, one half of which shall be paid to the informer, and the other half into the hands of His Majesty's Receiver General, to and for the public uses of this Province, and the support of the Government thereof.

X. And in order to prevent fraud in the matters aforefaid, Be it enacted by the Search warrant authority aforefaid, That it shall and may be lawful for any of His Majesty's Just to be granted on tices of the Peace, upon outh first to be made by any credible person, that such affidavit. person has good reason to believe that the Still or Stills employed by any Licenced person, does or do contain a greater number of gallons in the body or bodies thereof, than what is specified in his requisition or Licence, to grant a Search Warrant to a Peace Officer; taking with him the party making oath as aforefaid, and any one other person, for the purpose of examining the Still-House or other place where any Still or Stills may be let up, and of meaturing or gauging the bodies thereof: Provided always, that no such Warrant be executed before Sun-rife, or after Sun-fet.

XI. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That it shall not be lawful Distillers not exfor any person working any Licenced Still or Stills as aforesaid, to sell or barter retail, nor to be any quantity of fuch Distilled Liquors less than three gallons, nor shall it be law- tail. ful for the Secretary of the Province or any of his Agents, to grant a Licence for the purpose of Distilling Spirituous Liquors, to any person or persons Licenced at the lame time to retail Spirituous Liquors, or to grant a Licence for retailing Spisituous Liquors, to any person or persons Licenced at the same time to Distill Spicituous Liquors.

And be it further Enasted by the Authority aforefaid, That all monies which Payment of the Province or his Agents, under and by monies into the shall be received by the Secretary of the Province or his Agents, under and by wirtue of this Act, for Licences, to commence on the fifth day of September next, thall be paid by the Secretary into the hands of the Receiver General of this Proand that all monies hereafter eince, on or before the twentieth day of May so be received by virtue of this Aft, for Licences, to commence on the fixth day of April, shall be paid in to the "lid Receiver General on or before the twenty-
