FORM OF BEQUEST.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE SOCIETY HELD
AT BOWMANVILLE, IN THE BIBLE CHRISTIAN CHURCH,
JUNE 7th, 1875.

The Anniversary of the Society was held on Sunday and Monday, June 6th and 7th. On Sunday two sermons were preached ; in the morning at 10:30, by Bro. W. Jolliffe, and in the evening at 6:30, by Bro. A. Clarke. In the afternoon, a public service was held in connection with the Sabbath School, addresses were delivered by the Brethren, G. Webber, and J. W. Butcher.

On Monday at 3 o'clock, the public meeting commenced, Bro. C. Barker, one of the General Treasurers, in the chair. After devotional exercises and a brief speech from the chair, Bro. S. H. Rice, moved, seconded by Bro. A. Gordon :

That the Report an abstract of which has been read be adopted, printed and published under the direction of the Missionary Committee, and that this Meeting expresses its unanimous and cordial thanks to the friends who by varied and liberal contributions have placed the Society's receipts in advance of any preceding year, and to the indefatigable army of collectors to whose generous services so much is due.

The meeting then adjourned for tea.

At the adjourned meeting, the President in the chair, Bro. W. Kenner, moved, seconded by Bro. J. W. Pickard :

That this Meeting expresses its unfeigned gratitude to Almighty God for the continued tokens of his favor vouchsafed to this Society during the past year, through which favor new churches have been erected, additional Sabbath Schools instituted, the Church Membership revived, and above all, many souls brought to a saving knowledge of the truth.

The third Resolution was moved by Bro. G. Webber, seconded by Bro. M. Robins, a Layman, son of Bro. M. Robins, of the English Conference :

That while we rejoice in the good already accomplished, and the known adaptation of the Gospel to satisfy the immortal cravings of humanity's great heart, we deplore the wide extent of the kingdom of darkness, and believing the means employed can only be rendered effectual by the agency of the Holy Ghost, we pledge ourselves to pray more importunately for the Baptism of

sacred fire that the lives of Church Members may become more radiant with virtue and the organization of the Church more potent for good.

Bro. E. Roberts addressed the audience in favor of the reduction of the debt towards which object \$6,100 were promised.

The services were highly valued by large and deeply interested audiences.

REPORT:

Sin hath entered the world. "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God. There is none righteous, no, not one. God hath made man upright ; but they have sought out many inventions," are declarations from heaven, that are confirmed and illustrated in all ages and climes, by the experience and practice of the human race. Like sheep, they have wandered from the fold, become involved in the thickest of sin, and exposed to danger and death. Like prodigals, they have forsaken the attractions, comforts, guardianship and safety of home, for the haunts of vice, and the husks of Satan. Disloyal to King and Constitution, they have taken up arms against the Sovereign of the Universe. By nature degenerate, and by practice degenerating, they are being led farther and farther from God. The gradations by which they proceed, are walking in the counsel of the ungodly, standing in the way of sinners, and sitting in the seat of the scornful—earthly, sensual, and devilish. Of old, they "changed the glory of the uncorruptible God, into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four-footed beasts, and creeping things. Changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature, more than the Creator. Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, malice, full of envy, murder, debate,

deceit, malignity, whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful." Dictated by Infinite intelligence, such was a description of ancient Rome, and allowing for the veneering of civilization and the school-master, does not correct observation say, " Such is a truthful portraiture of the degenerate world to-day ? " The law of love hath departed from the heart—the law of truth and kindness from the tongue, and the law of equity from the conduct, the practical enquiry of teeming millions is now, as in days of yore, " What shall I eat, what shall I drink, and wherewithal shall I be clothed ? " " The dark places of the earth are still full of the habitations of cruelty."

The missionary enterprise represents the fact that " God is, in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself." " For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. It is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. He, by the grace of God, tasted death for every man." The eye is not better adapted to light, the ear to sound, the nose to fragrance, the hand to handle, the foot to walk, the teeth to mastication, and the stomach to digestion, than is the Gospel to meet the moral wants, and relieve the moral woes of humanity. Men of all ranks and conditions, from the philosopher in his study, to the shepherd in his tent, have proved it to be the power of God unto salvation. This is emphatically God's remedy for humanity's moral disease. Human quackery hath sought to displace the Great Physician, and Gil-ead's balm, but as ever, so now, there is salvation in none but Christ. " Neither is there salvation in any other, for there is none other name under heaven, given among men, whereby we must be saved." The Gospel points alone to Jesus, and cries, " Behold the Lamb of God that taketh away the sin of the world."

" Salvation, O thou bleeding Lamb,
To thee the praise belongs ;
Salvation shall inspire our hearts,
And dwell upon our tongues."

The Great Founder of our enterprise cried, " Go ye into all

the world and preach the Gospel to every creature." Every generation is instrumentally responsible for its regeneration. Our responsibilities do not lie a thousand years backward or forward, but to earth's teeming millions of the present. It is ours, by precept and example, to "pray in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God."

"Us in the stead of Christ, they pray—
Us in the stead of God, entreat ;
To cast our arms and sins away,
And find forgiveness at his feet."

To study the progression and apparent retrogressions of religious truth, is both a duty and a privilege. The ebbing and flowing of religious life are from neglect or performance of religious duty. Sad though it may be, the love of ease, and honor, worldly wealth, and pleasure, have often impeded the progress of divine truth. Never was the conflict between truth and error more real than now, and never the triumphs more widespread and signal than at the present. Rome, but recently under the sole control of the Pope, and guarded by French bayonets, is now the seat of a Protestant government under whose benign reign, the Divine Word has unrestricted circulation ; and Protestant Churches are ever multiplying. Austria for long under Papal domination, has recently broken from the leading strings of Pope Pius the ix., so far as to assert the right of civil government to rule the affairs of the State. In United Germany the intrepid and invincible Bismarck has rendered it too hot for the Jesuits, and while vindicating the rights of Caesar, is guiding the Nation on to the disendowment and disestablishment of the Church by the State. In England a justly celebrated ex-Premier has entered the arena of controversy and given such a popular exposure of the unsoundness and danger of Popish principles, and pretensions, as perhaps they never had before ; while the Liberation Society is laboring with such energy, and hope that a "Free Church in a Free State" is only a matter of time. In the annexation of the once Cannibal Islands of Fiji to the British Empire we have an omen that bodes good for its population. As in the days of Luther reformation is springing from *within* both the English, and Romish churches, while through the pulpit, platform, and the press influences are being generat-

ed farther-reaching in their compass, and more potent for good, than ever before. One fortification of Satan after another is falling before them like Jericho at the sound of Rams horns or Dagan before the Lord's Ark. Ends are realized and results reached in the compass of a short time, which formerly centuries were insufficient to bring about.

One pleasing feature of the Modern Church is to see its different sections studying the many essentials in which they are one; rather than the few and unessential points in which they differ; while by mutual concession they are becoming one in affection and effort to "help the Saviour's conquest on." Heart-cheering is it to us, as with all the spiritually-minded, to note God in his providence taking men from the humble walks of life as in the cases of Varley, Moody and Sankey, and so clothing them with divine wisdom and power, that by the preaching of Christ crucified the slumbering Church is woken into effort and expectancy. Sinners in tens of thousands are brought to weep for their sins. While Noblemen and classical scholars like Lord Kinnard and W. Ewart Gladstone, sit as pupils at their feet to hear the word of life.

The Saviour's command is "preach the Gospel to every creature." In the execution of this commission, the Church must observe her individual as her collective responsibility.

"Each hand must work, each heart must feel,
Till Christ the victory hath won."

As a small but not unimportant branch of the Christian Church, we have to record another year's labors with its shades and sunshines, trials and triumphs, successes and reverses, battles and victories.

BURLINGTON.—At this place the church hath been quickened; a barn and parsonage hath been built, and several hundred dollars raised towards expenses, but the favorable results have not been on a large scale. Yet considering the infancy of the station there are reasons for hopefulness.

BELLEVILLE.—Bears testimony to God's faithfulness in that His blessings have been bestowed both constantly and abundantly. Death hath not invaded the borders of the Church, peace and unity have delightfully prevailed. His presence hath

been felt in the midst of his assembled people, quite a few during special services held, embraced the pearl of great price ; and the membership stands 12 better at the close of the year than at the last returns, the friends have liberally sustained the cause among them, and a bright future is anticipated.

CAMPBELLFORD.—Amid a few drawbacks presents some encouraging features.

CLINTON.—Hath experienced a year of anxiety and toil. The toil hath not been unrewarded. A stable hath been built, the parsonage comfortably furnished, the quarterly and missionary receipts put considerably in advance of last year, a church partly built at Summer's Hill, with a prospect of being dedicated free of debt. A library purchased for Clinton Sunday School, and the church membership increased 25.

CLEVELAND MISSION.—Reports for the first time with dolorous note. Disunion has existed among its members ; financial depression in the country has told sensibly on the mission ; special effort hath been crowned with but little apparent success. Still the congregations improve, circuit claims have been provided for, and hope is in the ascendant.

COLCHESTER.—Reports good Sabbath evening's congregations, the social means of grace well attended. Spiritual health of members good and gradually improving ; their contributions liberal. Devotional attachment increasing, and the Sabbath School and Temperance cause doing well.

DEREHAM.—Has had reason to rejoice over unbroken peace prevailing throughout the societies ; good Sabbath Schools, prosperous Bible classes, lukeworn professors, warmed by the sun of righteousness, backsliders reclaimed, and many sinners brought to God. At Salem, where the church was nearly empty, and no Sabbath School existed there is now a house nearly full with a successful Sabbath School and Bible class, of from 30 to 40 taught by the pastor, with the membership 30 better than a year ago.

FENELON.—Has suffered in membership from removals, in its Sabbath Schools from want of books and a sufficient number of clear-headed warm-hearted teachers. But is thankful for peace throughout its borders, for wiping out the debt on Cambray and Ebenezer churches, amounting to \$3,200 ; reducing the debt

on the parsonage receipts beyond members.

AT GREY.—Efficient work offered with by about the same cause, the public and the contrite we hope it is been dark and

HUNTERFORD.—Depressed trade local staff of preachers of conference of a few hundred attended, the improvement in the cause of God.

HAMILTON.—Made straightway. Sons have been in service of Saturday increased by attendance both better than the past prevails, and increasing spirit of salvation of those he looks for guidance.

HUNTINGDON.—Gains in its parish admitted 160 persons to meetings as witness means of grace and spiritual power of God.

INGERSOLL.—God's presence

on the parsonage at the falls, in raising its quarterly and missionary receipts beyond the previous year, and in having an increase of 10 members.

AT GREY.—A cause in Brussels is deemed essential to the efficient working of the station. Protracted services were interfered with by the severity of the weather; the membership is about the same; the society interests itself in the Temperance cause, the public means of grace have been seasons of refreshing, and the contributions of the friends liberal. Grey is still Grey, we hope it is with the dawn of a brighter day. The night hath been dark and protracted.

HUNTERFORD.—Speaks of difficulties arising from stoney soil, depressed trade, too wide a field for one preacher, deficiency in local staff of preachers, removal of some good friends and indifference of a few. It is encouraged by public services being well attended, the unfailing attachment of tried friends. Some improvement in church property, and the felt presence and power of God.

HAMILTON.—The pastor states that crooked places have been made straight; special efforts have been made, refreshing seasons have been realized, quite a few persons have forsaken the service of Satan for the service of Christ. The membership is increased by 13. The Sabbath School is prosperous, the attendance both large and uniform, the church Anniversary was better than the most sanguine expected. The spirit of harmony prevails, and an increased deadness to the world, and ever-increasing spiritual life, a burning and consuming zeal for the salvation of those who are drawn unto death and ready to be slain, he looks for greater and continued prosperity.

HUNTINGDON.—During the past year hath made improvements in its parsonage, cancelled a fair share of its church debt, admitted 16 on trial for membership, and speaks of the class-meetings as well attended, the members growing in piety, the means of grace generally seasons of refreshing and often of rich spiritual power and of its disposition to ascribe all the glory to God.

INGERSOLL.—Hath not been left without manifestations of God's presence, the cause in the town is making progress, the

class and prayer meetings have often been rich in divine influence, and by some of the members regularly attended. Special services have been held, attended with the quickening of believers and the conversion of sinners. The Sabbath School has an efficient superintendent and is doing well; the church expenses have been met, a new shed costing \$100 erected and paid for, and a portion of church debt removed. The membership is increased, and the prospects brighter.

AT LAMBETH.—The pastor complains of results not corresponding to the labor performed or hopes cherished. Ten weeks of special services were held, yet only three professed faith in Jesus, but in another part of the circuit there is an increase of 15 members. A lively interest is taken by the young in the Bible class and the ordinances of the sanctuary.

LINDSAY.—Recognizes its obligations to God for His goodness, rejoices in good congregations, commendable liberality on the part of the friends. A Sabbath School largely increased in the average of its attendance, an increase of members after allowing for removals and the withdrawal of Brysons, and receipts equal to meeting current expenses of Quarter Board, and the interest charged to the Church Estate. But deplores the fewness of conversions, the total indifference of many families to the affairs of religion where privileges abound, and the fact of its members falling short of that strength of faith, intensity of love, fervor of zeal, and unwavering devotion, which the standard of God's word demands.

LITTLE PRAIRIE.—Reports refreshing seasons in the public means of grace, improved congregations in the new church, a small numerical increase of members, and prosperous Sabbath Schools. But regrets that the outpouring of the holy spirit has not been more copious, the ingathering to the church more numerous, and that quite a few of the members retained evinced so little of the Christian character as to render their being dropped from the roll, a necessity, without improvement.

OSHAWA MISSION.—We again bear testimony to God's faithfulness in the fulfilment of his promises. During the year He hath been with us to bless us. We have not had the crowded

congregations we had before the church was enlarged, but generally they have been good. The prayer meetings have been better attended than last year; the class meetings remain about the same. We have suffered considerably from removals, no less than 21 having gone from amongst us, while three we trust have escaped to the Mansions of the Master. During the winter a series of special services were held, when a few souls professed faith in Christ; the pastor's sickness seemingly interfering with success when it appeared most promising. Unhappy differences during a large part of the year have marred the peace of the church, and doubtless retarded its progress. The state of feeling is much improved, a good spirit of hearing exists and several have been added to the church since the 4th Elder's meeting. The approved membership is 10 better than at the last returns. Our Sabbath School is efficiently conducted, and well taught. The adult class having a fuller attendance than ever before. A Mutual Improvement class meets once per week, having an average attendance of from 30 to 40 members. Last year was commenced with \$65 in the treasury and a Conference Grant of \$40. This year the balance was much less, the Conference Grant dispensed with. Yet the quarterly meeting added \$100 to Conference allowance for Minister's salary and have come out square at the close of the year. Seven hundred and fifteen dollars of church subscription have been paid in during the year leaving the premises \$558.51, in debt with an unpaid subscription and seat rent of \$435.57. The total contributions of the church exceed \$2,100, being an average per member of a little over \$21. Numerically our Sabbath School has improved in scholars considerably.

PERRYTOWN.—Suffers from a change of preachers in the midst of the year, removal of members, and a lack of interest on the part of many in the cause of God. Yet reports peace within its borders, congregations increased, and regular services and class meetings seasons of rich spiritual influence; a contract let for the building of a new church. Sabbath Schools progressing and of late a growing interest in the prosperity of God's cause.

PORT HOPE.—Has encountered storms, but the vessel hath

neither been driven from her moorings nor sunk in the sea. Death hath claimed certain members who, because best fitted to die, seemed most wanted in the church below. Several have proved unfaithful, a few by reprehensible behaviour have hindered the work of God. Notwithstanding which, the membership is nearly the same, the quarterly receipts from 15 to 20 per cent improved—the missionary monies advanced. The church debt hath been reduced and without the Conference Grant of \$100 last year made to the station the Quarter Board comes out square at the close; and while the great want of the church is felt to be personal holiness, there are those in it who by personal consecration to God's service, pursuing the path of the just, and earnest prayer, evince an earnest desire to see God's work prosper.

PICKERING.—Hath reduced its debt on Duffins' Creek Church by over \$300. Some showers of blessing have fallen, a few souls saved, but not enough to fill the vacancies occasioned by deaths, removals, unfaithfulness, &c. The Sabbath scholars either through great falling off or mistake of former returns, are considerably less. Still hard labor hath been put in and hearty friends support the cause.

PRINCE ALBERT.—The pastor writes in rather desponding tune. The measure of success prayed and hoped for hath not been realized, the social means of grace have been greatly slighted. The prayer and class meetings in some instances have been allowed to die unsympathized with and alone, and a low state of piety obtains. Some however, evince a deep interest in the word of God, and adorn their profession by consistent lives and earnestly contending for the faith once delivered to the saints. Quite a bit hath been done in the way of raising money; the Sabbath Schools are increasing in interest and value. While the great want in order to prosperity is more promptitude on the part of officials, more scriptural liberality, fuller consecration to Christ, and a richer baptism of the holy ghost.

FROM PALMERSTON.—The pastor writes: "Our church has passed safely through its infancy and by the blessing of God hath reached the fruit bearing period. The year has been one of considerable toil and anxiety. The new church was opened

in July. A parsonage hath been built 18 x 30 proving a saving to the mission in the item of rent of \$72. The property acquired is over \$2,000 value with a claim against it of only \$600, of which \$168 is subscribed. The Mission was opened in September, 1873. Last year we returned 14 members, now we have 32. We have no fear of the future, only let us see to it that in all we do we seek the glory of God."

WEST CAPE.—Rejoices over 40 persons professing faith in Christ and deliverance from the bondage of sin; an increase of 28 at the close of the year, large and attentive congregations; Sabbath Schools well sustained, an anniversary both interesting and profitable; the completion and dedication of a new church; the raising of quite a few hundreds of dollars for church purposes and at the receipts to quarter Board being about one third more than they were the previous year.

SUMMERSIDE.—Has a new church nearly ready for dedication, both handsome and serviceable; to the building and paying for which the friends have contributed right heartily, and according to the District Superintendant's report the work in P. E. I. generally is progressing very favorably.

SUTTON.—Hath been blessed with revivals at Sutton, Bethel, and Ravenshoe; hence, after allowing for deaths, removals, &c., reports an increase of members at Egypt, and Ebenezer, where school houses were bought and converted into churches, the debt hath been nearly paid. Pefferlow and Bell-Haven have been given up for lack of efficient workers. The report speaks favorably of spirituality and finance, congregations and Sabbath Schools.

ST. THOMAS.—Has had to encounter numerous difficulties, hence the members are about one half less and the teachers and scholars fewer than were returned last year; the latter is not to be wondered at, since 3 Sunday Schools have been started in the immediate neighborhood during the year.

TORONTO.—Has not been left without evidence of the divine favor. All asperities have ceased, mutual confidence and hearty co-operation have been manifest. In the possession of peace comfort hath been enjoyed. The Sabbath Schools are in an in-

couraging condition ; the financial report of things evokes gratitude. An annual revenue of \$350 for seat rent is secured. A fair share of the subscriptions to Church fund has been paid in. After fifteen removals and several dropped from the roll of membership, the report shows an increase over the last returns. The Missionary receipts have increased about \$60. Encouraged by the past, with a splendid edifice, ample accommodation, and hoping for a suitable pulpit supply, a future of very great usefulness is expected for Toronto.

UXBRIDGE.—Presents a hopeful aspect. Zion church hath been rebuilt at a cost of about \$700, all of which hath been met by the actually paid subscriptions of a few liberal friends ; the congregation is good and the Sabbath School large and prosperous. In the village an eligible lot with a parsonage hath been purchased with room for the church, to which it hath since been removed. The Holy Spirit is being poured out and over thirty persons (principally heads of families) have professed faith in Christ. The Sabbath School supplied with additional and regenerate teachers is in a flourishing condition.

WIARTON.—Has had the usual experience of hard labor under difficulties. The snow hath been deep, the roads rough and at times impassable. The ground is very extensive, and by reason of being so large is ill cultivated and slender in fruit-bearing. With two men's labor it has 21 less members, 10 less scholars than last year, with \$500 deficiency. Three places have been given up, one taken in at which the people had neither seen a preacher, nor heard a sermon for 6 years. The Temperance cause is progressing, and the pastor states that in order to work the ground they now hold a young man must be sent to the back part of the station, which could be worked without a horse, and an occasional change effected with the pastor residing at Wiarton.

WINDSOR.—Is a new Mission reporting for the first full year of its existence. During which a neat church hath been built, and is nearly paid for, the numbers attendant on the Sabbath School considerably increased, the membership a little improved and the class and cottage prayer meetings have been sources of delight. With a good congregation and liberality of mind, there appears a fair prospect of the friends at Windsor achieving success.

The following statistical table shows that the society employ 42 itinerant preachers, assisted by 65 local preachers, who preach in 75 churches, with 38 other preaching places; that 28 have been removed by death 188 migrated, 230 remain on trial for membership, 1885 members, making 2,115 total; teachers 382, scholars, 3,019. Showing an increase, considering that Colborne last year passed from the list of missions to that of circuits, and that Campbellford has made no returns of teachers and scholars, of 3 itinerants, 1 church, 9 deaths, 20 removals, 142 members, 38 teachers and 205 scholars, and a decrease of 1 local preacher, 10 preaching places, 17 received from other circuits.
