| Germans Annihilated or Scattered by Terrific Bombardment. $\qquad$ <br> Canadian headquarters in France, via London; April $9-$ (By Stewart Lyon, spectal correspondent of the Canadian Press)-The crest of the Vimy Ridge has been carried. The strongest defensive position of the enemy on the westem tront has been captured by the army of Sir Douglas Hats, and the Oanadian corps was given the place offifonor in the great event, being strongly supported by some of the most famous of the British formations. The attack was pre ceded by a bombardment which continued for several days, and in which guns of the heavlest calibre, formerly used on only the biggest battleships, took part.
