

Shipping Notes. The schooner Hamming Bird, from Fall River for this port is ashore in Herring Cove, having been driven on by the ice. The bark J. Walter Seemuller, at San Francisco 27th ult., made the passage from Valparaiso to the Farallones in 36 days, one of the best passages, it not the best on record. The brig Anna Lindsay, of Hillsboro, N. B., lately on shore, having completed her repairs at Eastport, sailed for this port on the 30th ult. The schooner Susan B. Thurlow, from this port for Havana, was boarded on the 23rd ult. by the U. S. Revenue steamer Blosswood, and reported that George Carleton, one of the crew belonging to this port, aged 21 years, was lost overboard of Dark Harbor, Grand Manan. The ship Virginia, Cochrane, from Antwerp for Savannah, which was ashore at Broad Sands, on 17th October, and got off 30th, has been repaired and resumed her voyage. Advice by cable to Messrs. Robt. Robinson & Son reports the safe arrival of the bark Argon, Jones, master, at Antwerp, after a quick voyage of 19 days from Philadelphia. The wreck of the bark Charlie Wood, Jones, wrecked on the east side of Campobello, on the 20th ult., was sold at auction on the 27th. The hull, anchors, chains, dunnage, etc., realized about \$1300. The sails were sold for \$250. Brig Altaga, McLain, from Nova Scotia for New York, sunk a quarter of a mile off Libby Island on the 27th December. The captain reports was in sight of Cape Ann, experienced a heavy westerly gale, and was driven back, and anchored under the lee of Libby Island December 25 in fifteen fathoms of water, the brig badly holed up. Ice continued to make on her until she sunk. Captain and crew saved. The A was five years old, and hailed from Kempt, N. S. The bark J. F. Whiting, Spicer, built at Spencer's Island, Parahor, N. S., and owned by Hon. Dr. Tupper and others, sailed yesterday for Cut'a with 200 tons, after having been detained several days waiting for sails promised by an Oak Point, N. S. maker, for the first of November. Last week an effort was made to send the sails to Digby, but owing to the bad state of the roads, only part of them reached there before the sailing of the Sea, and the bark went to sea yesterday without the rest of them. She had a very considerable list, "not enough ballast and too much dunnage" being the verdict of the old salts on the wharves. The circulation of the DAILY TRIBUNE is rapidly increasing.
