

## BILL.

An Act to amend " the Medical Act for Upper Canada."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Medical Act for Upper Preamble. Canada"; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :--

Distribution of penalties. 6. Of all penalties recovered under the thirty-fourth section of the said Act, or under this Act, one half shall go to the prosecutor or the party laying the information, and the other half to the Council for the use thereof.
