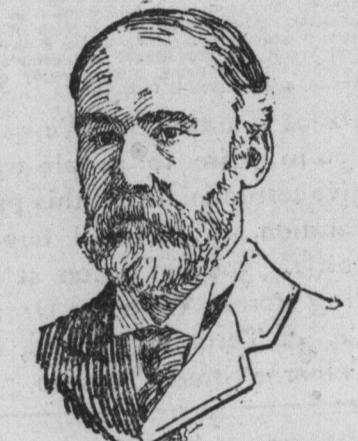

RAILWAYS AND "PATRIOTISM"

Opposition to the proposed railway whereby the Great Northern will obtain access to the Crow's Nest coal country seems to emanate entirely from the Canadian Pacific Railway. We have not heard of any objections from British Columbia as a whole, nor from any of the municipalities or counties of that province. And practically the only argument urged against the project of the C.P.R. is that the chartering of a railway to the international boundary would have the effect of dividing the province into two territories from Canada to the United States. The C.P.R. appeals to Parliament to disallow the charter, on patriotic and national grounds. The Canadian trunk should be the best of all corporations to raise the national and patriotic cry. Patriotic sentiment finds no place in the management of the C.P.R. The C.P.R. is a Grand Trunk in disguise. The C.P.R. was lately on the point of abandoning St. John for Boston. An argument based on national sentiment comes with ill grace from a corporation that is ready any time to violate the principles which it thinks ought to be applied to others, but not to itself. Both the C.P.R. and Grand Trunk discriminate in favor of the United States as against Canadian shippers. The motive for shipping a car of live stock from Toronto to Montreal has been charged on Chicago is charged between Chicago and Montreal. Parliament should not waste much time in considering the patriotic argument when faced by a selfish railway corporation.

JEALOUSY CAUSED MURDER

A Tragedy at Stony Lake, North of Havelock, in Which William Hull Was the Victim. MURDERER'S NAME IS SHARPE.

Hull was instantly killed and his slayer has not yet been captured. Havelock, Feb. 21.—Frank Sharpe, about 60 years of age, was last summer married to a woman who had been living in a house at Stony Lake, north of Havelock, for some time. Sharpe had been away from home for some time, and when he returned he found his wife in the company of a man named William Hull, who was sitting in the room. The latter threw up his hands and said: "Don't do it. Don't do it. Don't do it." Sharpe then shot Hull in the chest, and the bullet shattered Hull's hand and pierced his heart. Sharpe then fled from the scene, and Hull was found dead in the room. Sharpe has established himself at his home at Stony Lake, and has threatened to shoot anyone who attempts his arrest. FROM CHICAGO TO HAMBURG. During the past year or two numerous transportation schemes for utilizing the deepened St. Lawrence route have been mentioned in the press, but most of them have failed to materialize. One of the latest projects, however, is maturing, and we shall see it put into execution on the opening of navigation. We refer to the organization of a company in Chicago to establish a thru steamship service from the city of Toronto to Hamburg. Four vessels will form the line. They are all to be new and made to conform to the dimensions of the St. Lawrence Canal locks. Three of the ships are in the water, and the fourth is to be launched the beginning of next month. The vessels have already been named, and are to be known as the Northwestern, Northman, Northtown and Northeastern. The Northwestern will leave Chicago harbor on April 24 for Hamburg, with a cargo of boxed meats, agricultural implements, lumber, iron and steel manufactured into various shapes and some copper metal. The ships will not attempt to handle fresh meats, but bacon and hams will be taken, and special provision for their preservation to be made. Special advantages in the transportation of goods are expected to be found in the new ships. These products are carried in ice-houses, barrels, tubs or other wooden receptacles. If they are sent to the seaboard by rail they are handled twice before starting across the Atlantic Ocean. As they are not handled again, the leakage and breakage when sent by sea is a loss equal to the cost of transportation of the whole cargo. By the thru steamship this loss will be avoided. The outcome of the venture will be awaited with interest by all the cities on the great lakes. Chicago is one of the most remote cities from the seaboard, and if the experiment is successful, it means its extension to all the other large lake cities, including Detroit, Cleveland, Buffalo, Duluth and Toronto.
