qualities of butter, and has the benefit of a considerable margin over them, as it costs no less to make poor butter than good. Both are made from cream. The article which brings 30 cents per lb. should cost more to make than that which is worth half that price. At the present moment the manufacture of "Stene" and oleomargarine receive unusual encouragement because of the high price of fine creamy butter, and butter quoted now from 16 to 20 cents, the whole has much to fear from such substitutes, especially butters of different grades and originally packed in various shapes which are repackaged uniformly, salted and otherwise prepared, chiefly by means of "Walker's Butter Worker," to suit the home and export markets. The only preventive for the substitution of oleomargarine for butter in the general consumption is improvement in the making. It is known that prime butter has nothing to fear, that fresh butter will always sell in preference to imitation butter, consequently the efforts of the dairymen must be directed to secure the two advantages: a prime article and a prompt sale. -Journal of Commerce.

The Canning of the Fox. Some fishermen on the west coast of Ireland were in the habit of going to a small island, a few hundred yards from the mainland, in quest of bait. The island was inhabited by large numbers of rabbits, and could be seen in preference by wading, the water there being only a few inches deep. One morning they went in their boat quite early, it being high tide, and on landing saw a dead fox lying on the beach. The fox of the animal was all bedegged, and its head was swollen. One of the men remarking that his skin was worth something pitched him into the boat. Procuring their bait they returned to the mainland, and the man who had assessed himself of the fox seized him by the tail and flung him on shore. As soon as the animal struck the beach he picked himself up with considerable agility for a dead fox, and shot off like a flash among the cliffs, while the men stood staring at each other in mute astonishment. The men concluded that he had crossed over to the island during the night, when the tide was low, in search of rabbits, and finding in the morning that he was cut off from the mainland, contented himself with the expectation of thereby procuring a passage to the shore in the boat--an expectation which was fully realized.

HAND AND STEAM MANUFACTURED JOINTERY--It is freely admitted that by the employment of the hand, working machinery, considerable economy is effected, but no doubt the cost of laying down a number of machines would severely tax the resources of the average contractor; and, further, it would be a question with him, whether he would be able to keep the various machines anything like fully employed. No doubt his workmen would in course of time become accustomed to the use of more than one machine, so that they could be employed at those machines for which there was a workman; but it must be remembered that perfect facility in the management of a number of machines, that he can attain by constantly working one particular machine and no other; and it is in this respect that the large machinery establishments situated all over the country. From them he will in every probability be able to obtain tenders for supplying the woodwork, which will be at prices lower than he himself, with his want of machinery, is able to produce it, and he will not only be able to get greater despatch, but it will preclude the necessity of his having to hold on hand a costly stock of seasoned wood, which in itself is a serious drawback upon the resources of a class of tradesmen who are not usually overburdened with capital. -Timber Trades Journal.

OLEOMARGARINE. When first brought into use, oleomargarine, as the name indicates, was extracted from the marrow of cattle, and as such would have been too costly; but chemists found out that fat answered just as well for the purpose; or, perhaps, oleomargarine, with its Greek name, was placed as a screen to conceal the vile fatty matters used in the composition, for no more marrow exists in the oleomargarine than in that renowned French pomatum known as mouton de bœuf (ox marrow pomatum), as a New York exporter of our acquaintance once learnt to his cost. He thought that if the consumption of Piver's ox-marrow pomade was so world-wide, a pomatum made from buffalo marrow would also prove a success. He, therefore, obtained from the fur west several tons of this new article of export and shipped it to Paris. The well known perfumer wrote back that he held the consignment at his, the shipper's, disposal, as, owing to the presence of margarine, marrow could not be used for the purpose, and that nothing but pure Russian tallow entered the composition of ox-marrow pomade. And now marrow from being improperly employed as a lubricant of youthful locks has become a lubricant of the staff of life, perhaps with little less propriety. Oleomargarine, whatever it be, is a dangerous competitor for the ordinary
