An Act to reduce the Quorum of the Court of Error and Appeal in Upper Canada.

HER MAJESTY, &c., enacts as follows:

Preamble.

I. The Sixth Section of the thirteenth Chapter of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the Court of Error and Appeal" is hereby repealed. Sec. 6, of c. 13, Con. Stat. U. C. repealed

5 II. The following Section, or paragraph, shall be substituted for the repealed Section, and shall, in lieu thereof, be read as the Sixth Section of the said Act: New section substituted.

"Five members of the Court shall be necessary to constitute a Quorum of Court."
