Mr. Tait, from the committee on naval affairs, reported, *in part*, the following resolutions, which were read.

Resolutions expressive of the sense of congress of the gallant conduct of captain Thomas Macdonough, the officers, seamen, marines, and infantry serving as marines, on board the United States'squadron on lake Champlain.

*Resolved by the senate and house of representatives of the United States of America in congress assembled*, That the thanks of congress be, and the same are hereby presented to captain Thomas Macdonough, and, through him, to the officers, petty officers, seamen, marines, and infantry serving as marines, attached to the squadron under his command, for the decisive and splendid victory gained on lake Champlain, on the eleventh of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, over a British squadron of superior force.

*Resolved*, That the president of the United States be requested to cause gold medals to be struck, emblematical of the action between the two squadrons, and to present them to captain Macdonough and captain Robert Henly; and also to lieu-

tenant Stephen Cassin, in such manner as may be most honorable to them; and that the president be further requested to present a silver medal, with suitable emblems and devices, to each of the commissioned officers of the navy and army serving on board; and a sword to each of the midshipmen and sailing masters, who so nobly distinguished themselves in that memorable conflict.

*Resolved*, That the president of the United States be requested to present a silver medal, with like emblems and devices, to the nearest male relative of lieutenant Peter Gamble, and of lieutenant John Stansbury, and to communicate to them the deep regret which congress feel for the loss of those gallant men, whose names ought to live in the recollection and affection of a grateful country.

*Resolved*, That        months' pay be allowed, exclusively of the common allowance, to all the petty officers, seamen, marines, and infantry serving as marines, who so gloriously supported the honor of the American flag on that memorable day.
