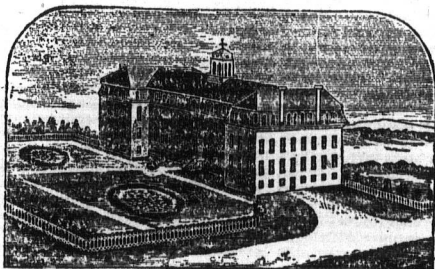

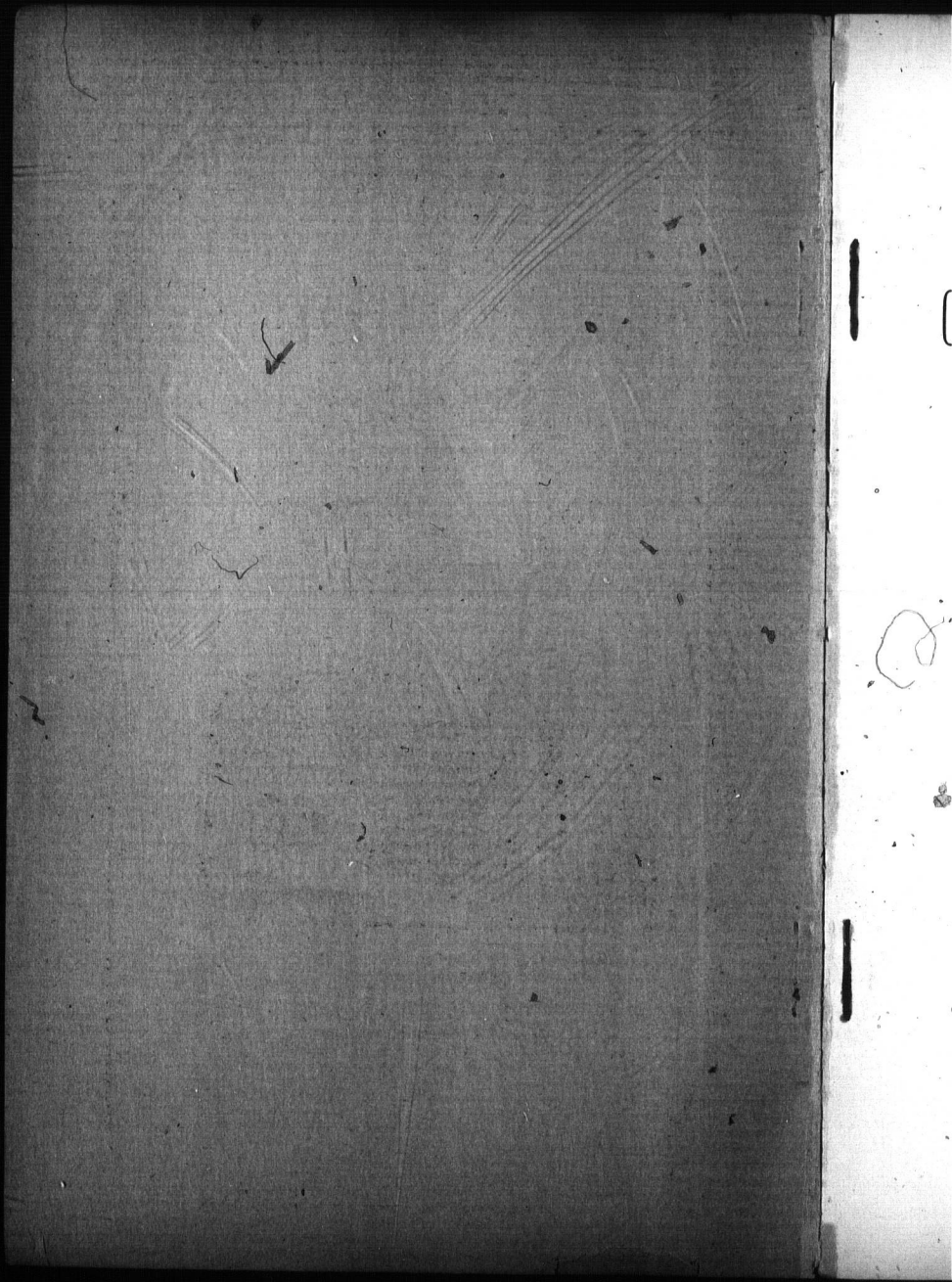

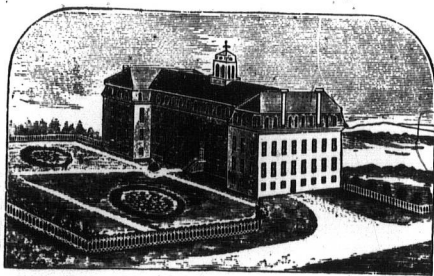

COLLEGE SAINTE-CROIX

Farnham, Comté de Missisquoi, P. Q.

CANADA

Cette institution, fondée en 1875, est dirigée par les religieux de Sainte-Croix, bien connus au Canada et aux États-Unis par leurs nombreux établissements d'éducation.

Farnham, comme on le sait, est le point où convergent plusieurs des principales lignes de chemin de fer de la province; ce qui donne au collège Sainte-Croix une position exceptionnellement avantageuse pour la facilité des communications avec les grands centres du Canada et des États-Unis.

Agréablement situé sur la rive droite de la rivière Yamaska, dans un beau site et sur un terrain élevé, l'établissement possède de beaux et grands bâtiments, une cour spacieuse munie de tout ce qui est nécessaire pour l'amusement des élèves.

L'excellence des cours au collège Sainte-Croix semble suffisamment démontrée par la prospérité rapide de l'établissement, par le grand nombre d'élèves sortis de son sein, qui occupent actuellement les positions les plus avantageuses dans le commerce.

Le but des religieux de Sainte-Croix, à Farnham comme ailleurs, est d'offrir aux familles les garanties d'une éducation essentiellement chrétienne et les avantages d'une solide instruction.

Les maîtres s'efforcent avant tout d'inspirer à leurs élèves une piété éclairée, de développer en eux de nobles et généreux sentiments et de les initier à des habitudes de travail, d'économie et de politesse.

L'enseignement, purement commercial, comprend toutes les branches du haut commerce. Il se donne simultanément dans les deux langues française et anglaise, en cinq ans.

CLASSE D'AFFAIRES.

Les élèves qui ont fait leur troisième année sont admis en cette classe. Elle comprend deux ans, et a pour but de donner aux élèves l'avantage de se livrer à la pratique des affaires. Dans ce département, on s'occupe de ventes, d'achats, d'opérations de banque et, enfin, de transactions commerciales de toutes sortes. L'administration n'a rien épargné pour en rendre les cours aussi attrayants que profitables. Le local est spacieux, l'aménagement fait avec goût et bien adapté au besoin du cours.

Les élèves finissants de cette classe qui conservent aux examens les trois quarts des points alloués, reçoivent un brevet de capacité, pourvu toutefois qu'ils aient subi des examens satisfaisants en français.

1.—Les paiements se font d'avance en trois termes ; le premier, en entrant, au commencement de septembre ; le deuxième, au 1er décembre ; et le troisième, au 1er de mars.

2.—Une remise n'est accordée que pour une absence de trois semaines consécutives. Il n'y a pas de déduction pour le mois de juin.

3.—Les livres et autres objets classiques sont fournis par la maison au prix ordinaire de la librairie.

4.—Les abonnements au médecin sont obligatoires et payables dès le premier mois, sans réduction.

5.—Les frais d'infirmerie sont payés comme un extra.

6.—A partir du 15 avril, on ne fait plus de crédit.

7.—Toutes lettres et envois sont soumis à l'inspection de l'autorité.

8.—Tout élève venant d'un autre établissement doit présenter un certificat de bonne conduite de la part du président du dit établissement.

9.—Les demandes de sortie pour affaires doivent être sérieusement motivées, et faites, autant que possible, par une lettre adressée au supérieur de la maison.

10.—Il n'y a pas de costume particulier.

11.—Des religieuses donnent leur attention au soin et à la propreté des jeunes gens, aussi bien qu'au linge des élèves en général.

12.—Les parents recevront à chaque semestre un bulletin constatant les progrès, l'application, la conduite et la santé de leurs enfants.

This Institution, founded in 1875, is directed by the Religious of Holy Cross, well known throughout Canada and the States for their educational establishments.

Farnham, is a junction place for many of the principal Railways of the province. This gives exceptional advantages for facility of communication with the great central places of Canada and the States.

Agreeably situated on the right bank of the Yamaska river on a beautiful site, and elevated ground, the establishment possesses large and commodious buildings, spacious play-grounds provided with all things necessary for the amusement of students.

The excellency of the studies pursued at this College seems to be sufficiently demonstrated by the establishment's rapid prosperity and the large number of its ALUMNI, now occupying the most prominent positions in Trade.

The aim of the Religious of Holy Cross, at Farnham as elsewhere, is to impart to their pupils an essentially Christian Education, as well as solid instruction.

The teachers endeavor first of all to inspire their students with an enlightened piety; to develop in them noble and generous sentiments, and to initiate them to habits of work, economy and politeness.

The course of studies, among which religious instruction stands pre-eminent, is purely commercial. It is given simultaneously in both languages, and generally comprises five years.

BUSINESS CLASS.

Students who have finished their 3rd year are admitted into this Class. It comprises a course of two years, and has for its object to give to the students a practical knowledge of business affairs. Actual business is also taught, such as buying and selling, manufacturing, banking and all commercial transactions. The faculty endeavors to make this class complete and profitable to the students. The class-room is large, and is fitted up in a banking-house manner. Students are required to pass three examinations a year; and to receive their diplomas, they must have an average of at least three-fourths of the points allowed; besides, they will be obliged to pass a satisfactory examination in French.

- 1.—Payments are made in advance, as follows: The first payment, in the beginning of September; the second, on the first of December; and the third, on the first of March.
 - 2.—A deduction will be made for an absence of three consecutive weeks only. Students leaving in June will pay for the whole month.
 - 3.—Books and Stationery are sold at Bookseller's price.
 - 4.—Subscription to the Physician of the House is obligatory and must be paid at the beginning of the scholastic year, without reduction.
 - 5.—Infirmary expenses are extra.
 - 6.—Nothing will be sold on credit after the 15th of April.
 - 7.—All mail matter must be submitted to the inspection of the Superior or his delegate.
 - 8.—Pupils coming from another institution must bring a certificate of recommendation from the President of the former institution.
 - 9.—Parents who desire their children home on particular occasions, will write to the Superior, and the permission will be given only for sufficient reasons.
 - 10.—No uniform is required.
 - 11.—Sisters devote their attention to the cleanliness and well being of young children, are also charged with the care of the students' linen, and have charge of the sick.
 - 12.—Parents will receive semi annually bulletins of the progress, application, conduct and health of their children.
