**APOL (LOUIS).** The Hague.

Painter of Landscapes, principally Winter Scenes. Born 1850. Awarded Medals: The Hague, Amsterdam, Munich, etc. Member of the International Jury of Awards, Chicago World's Fair. Chevalier of the Order of the Eikenkroon. Is represented in the Museums of Amsterdam, The Hague, Rotterdam, Dordrecht, and in many other important collections.

Painter of Figures and Street-scenes. Born 1864. Pupil of the Academies of Amsterdam and Antwerp. Honorable mention, Paris Exhibition, 1900; St. Louis Exhibition, 1904—Medal.

**BASTERT (NICOLAAS).**

Painter of Landscape and City Views. Born 1854. Pupil of the Academies of Amsterdam and Antwerp. Awarded Grand Gold Medals, Munich, Amsterdam. Medals: Chicago, Paris, Antwerp and Brussels. Is represented in the Royal Pinakotek, Munich, and St. Louis Exposition.

4 Heath.

**BLES (DAVID).** Born 1821. Died 1899 at The Hague.

Painted humorous subjects, chiefly of family life of the 18th Century. Received numerous Decorations and Medals of the Netherlands and foreign countries. Represented in all the Museums and the Private Collections of the Netherlands.

5 Bad Language.

**BLOMMERS (BERNARDUS JOHANNES).** Scheveningen.

Painter of Dutch Interiors and Seaside Scenes and Fisher Life. Pupil of the Academy of The Hague. Gold Medals awarded at The Hague, Amsterdam, Munich, Brussels. Honorary Diplomas: Antwerp, Amsterdam, Chicago, Brussels. Gold Medal: Paris, 1900;



St. Louis, 1904. Decorations: Chevalier of the Order of Saint Michael of Bavaria, Leopold of Belgium, and Nederlandsche Leenw. His work is represented in the principal Museums of Holland and in many national and private collections.

**CHATTEL DU (FREDERICUS JACOBUS).** Scheveningen.

Painter of Dutch Landscapes. Born 1856. Awarded Gold Medals in Amsterdam, Berlin, Paris, and Munich. Decorations: Officer of the Order of Oranje-Nassau, Chevalier of Leopold of Belgium and Saint Michael of Bavaria. Represented in many National Museums.

Painter of Landscape and Figure Pictures. Born 1850. Pupil of his brother-in-law, Anton Mauve. Bronze Medal, Paris, 1900; Honors at St. Louis, 1904.

**VAN DRIESTEN (A. J.).** Leiden.

Well known among the younger Dutch Artists of Holland. As a Landscape Painter his pictures are owned in good collections.
