Dunbar, of Cleveland, must remain suspended until he apologizes to President Edwards, of the Cheveland Driving Park. Dunbar, who is the driver of Clingstone, had a quarrel with Edwards and applied some very opprobrious epithets to him. The Board expelled H V Hemis, proprietor of the Hotel Richelieu and publisher of the Chicago Horseman. Bemis was charged with having started two horses owned and controlled by him in a heat race, which is contrary to the rules. Hamilton Busby, editor of the Turf, Field and Farm, was the complainant, Bemis has \$25,000 libel suitagainst Busby growing out of the charges. The race occurred at Albany in 1884 and since that the editors have been was in their papers. The horses Belle Find Onward are expelled with Mr. Bemis. He and the horses can only be reinstated by refunding all the money won on the race at Albany.
