EVADING NEUTRALITY LAWS.

MINIONS OF WAR SHIPPED UNDER THE SPANISH FLAG.
Two cruisers sail from England for the Japanese service—Li Hung Chang still in power—The reported naval engagements of Corea discussed—News in China expressive.

London, Aug. 6.—Two fast vessels left England Saturday flying the Spanish flag. Another will follow in a few days. The three vessels are partly fitted out as cruisers, and will be transferred on the high seas to the Japanese Government. All munitions of war now loading for China and Japan clear under Spanish and Portuguese flags.

A despatch to the Central News from Tien Tsin says that the Japanese continue to direct the war preparations of the Chinese, and has reviewed the newly-arrived troops.
