## ELEVENTH ANNUAL REPORT.

---

I beg to lay before you the Eleventh Annual Report, which records the progress made during another busy and successful year.

For the first time in our annals, the circulation of books for home reading has exceeded half a million, and the addition of 33,571 books issued in the Reference Library has brought the total circulation up to 535,727; an increase of 93,349 over that of 1893, or 17.4 per cent.

This large advance on former years does not entirely arise from any special increase in the Central Library, but is contributed to by all the Branches.

By a reference to page 12 of the Statistical Tables, it will be seen that the increase has been evenly distributed over all classes of books, the only one which shows a diminution in percentage being Fiction, which is now reduced to 46 per cent. over the whole Library, and 40.6 per cent. at the Central. As has been pointed out in 1891, by my predecessor in this chair, the whole tendency of the circulation since the establishment of the Library has been in the direction of a reduction in the issue of Fiction, which, amounting to 65.5 per cent. in 1885, only 46 per cent. in 1894.

The Circulating Libraries have now grown to 48,027 books, against 21,105 in 1884, and, as will be seen by the following table, the number of books other than Fiction have increased more rapidly than light literature.

The Reference Library now numbers 41,221 volumes. The collection of Pamphlets which it contains is one of great value, and recent additions have made it very complete. The Chief Librarian hopes to make arrangements during the present year for a complete catalogue of them. The space at the disposal of readers in the Reference Library is now so fully occupied, especially in the afternoon, that it is difficult at times to obtain a seat. The unrestricted use of the Encyclopædias, Dictionaries, Almanacs, etc., have tended to add much to its popularity.

The Reading Room for the Unemployed, opened last season, has been re-opened this year. It is constantly filled, and is thoroughly appreciated by workingmen as it affords them shelter and warmth, and entertainment in the shape of an abundance of reading matter.

The Register of those to whom tickets have been granted has not been thoroughly revised since the opening of the Library, and, by resolution of the Board, arrangements were made in November, for a re-issue of all tickets applied for before February 1st of this year, all not applied for being cancelled after that date. This will remove from the Register the names of a number of persons deceased, or removed from the city, and relieve from responsibility a large number of guarantors.

During the past summer, the Council of the City of London presented to the Library a beautiful collection of medals, struck between the years 1834-1894, to commemorate the visit of distinguished personages to the city. These have been gratefully acknowledged, and placed in an appropriate glass case in the entrance hall, with printed labels attached.

Among the more important books added during the year have been: The Reliquary, 33 vols.; La Perouse's Voyage round the World, 3 vols.; Stevens' Facsimiles of MSS. relating to America, Vol. 19-22; Dupaix, Antiquites Mexicaines, 2 vols.; Pinart, Cartes, etc., Etats-Unis et Canada; Bartsch, Le Peintre Graveur, 23 vols.; Transactions of Royal Historical Society, 16 vols.; Drummond, Ancient Scottish Weapons; Wheatley, Remarkable Bindings in British Museum; Stanford's London Atlas; Gotch, Architecture of the Renaissance in England, 2 vols.; The Auk, 18 vols.; Original Coloured Drawings of Canadian Birds; Œuvres de Corneille, 12 vols.; Barbier, Dictionnaire des ouvrages anonymes, 5 vols.; Quaritch, General Catalogue of Books, large paper, 8 vols.; Brett, Arms and Armour; Partington, Weapons, etc., of Natives of Pacific Islands, 3 vols.; Collections of Massachusetts Historical Society, 19 vols.; Society of Dilettanti, Ancient Sculpture, 2 vols.; Niles Weekly Register, 63 vols.; Book of Public Arms; Historic Churches of America; Palæographical Society, Facsimiles, 5 vols.; Halfpenny, Gothic Ornaments in York Cathedral; Anderson, Pictorial Arts of Japan; Chaucer, edited by Skeat, 5 vols.; Bay State Monthly, 13 vols.; Autographic Mirror, 4 vols.; Pennell, Pen Drawing, 2nd ed.; Williamson, John Russell, R.A.; Bartlett, Concordance to Shakespeare; Meyrick and Smith, Costume of Original Inhabitants of Great Britain, 2 vols.; Howard and Crisp, Visitation of England and Wales, 2 vols.; Larned, History for Ready Reference, 3 vols.; Michel, Rembrandt, his life, work and times, 2 vols.; Journals of House of Assembly, Upper Canada, 1801-2.

The accounts of the Board have been audited, and statements of receipts and expenditures appended. All reasonable economy has been practised during the past year.

It is most gratifying to learn that the public are taking a deeper interest in the Library. It is the opinion of some that a large number of our citizens are not yet aware of the advantages to be derived from their Free Public Library. All such I invite to see for themselves, confident that they will appreciate the value of the institution. Make yourselves acquainted with what is the common property of all citizens, and learn to use it.

I take pleasure in stating that the Chief Librarian, the Secretary and other assistants and employees of the Library have performed their duties in every way satisfactory to the Board.
