The circumstances of his death...
New Haven, Ct., Sept. 11.—In Lanseville,
Litchfield county, about two miles from
New Milford, John Waters, a middle-aged
farmer, was shot and killed by George
Knowles last night. The murderer is a son of Dr.
Charles Knowles, who, together with his brother
Jay, resides in Lanseville. About 10 o'clock
last night the Knowles brothers died, leaving
considerable property, most of which was
willed to Jay. For a time Jay occupied the farm, but
was forced to leave it and move to another part
of the town away from Dr. Charles Knowles and
his son. In June Dr. Charles Knowles and his son
George also moved to another part of the town.
The house was the scene of a fight which was
the talk of the village. Last night a "vigilance
committee" of about 100 men, including many
of the town's leading citizens, gathered at the
house and demanded an entrance to the house,
which was refused. The door was then forced
open and the men entered. Dr. Knowles and his
son were shot and killed. The body of Joseph
Cameron was found on the sands near Muriel
street.
