An Act to confirm the original survey of the third and fourth Concessions in the Township of Crowland.

WHEREAS Henry Buchner and others, inhabitants of the Township of Crowland, in the County of Welland, have by their petition represented, that a certain survey of the third and fourth Concessions of Crowland aforesaid, made in the year of our Lord 1854, is erroneous, and have prayed that the original survey thereof, as traced out and confirmed by the survey of Zenos Fell, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of our Lord 1855, may be permanently established and declared to be the true survey; And whereas the representations contained in the said petition, and the report of the said Zenos Fell upon such survey so by him made, and the proofs adduced in support thereof, shew conclusively that the said survey of 1854 is erroneous and ought to be set aside: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The survey made by Edmund J. Decew, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of our Lord 1854, with the view of establishing the division line between the third and fourth Concessions of the Township of Crowland aforesaid, shall be and the same is hereby cancelled and set aside.

II. The original survey of the third and fourth Concessions of Crowland aforesaid, as traced out and confirmed by Zenos Fell, Deputy Provincial Surveyor, in the year of our Lord 1855, shall be taken to have been and the same is hereby declared to be permanently established and confirmed.

III. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
