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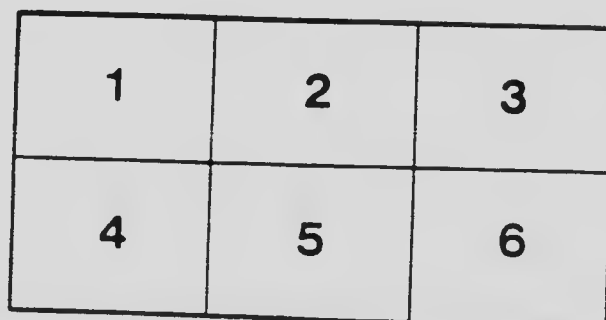
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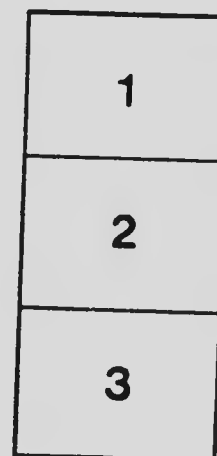

SIR,—I have the honour to report to you regarding 140 samples of canned tomatoes purchased throughout the Dominion of Canada in September and October of this year.

With a single exception in which slight decomposition was found, the contents of the cans were in good condition.

The cans in which tomatoes are packed appear, so far as this inspection goes, to vary in capacity, and to fall into three groups, in the matter of size.

1. *Large Size*.—About 1,050 cubic centimetres or approximately 37 ounces. Of this size 111 samples are found in the present collection.

2. *Medium Size*.—About 875 cubic centimetres, or approximately 31 ounces. Of this size 24 samples were found.

3. *Small Size*.—About 650 cubic centimetres, or approximately 23 ounces. Of this size 5 samples were found.

Large Size.

The total contents of cans of these sizes vary from 29 to 25.9 ounces; 14 samples being below 32 ounces and 19 samples being above 34 ounces. Thus 78 samples or 70% of the whole contain from 33 to 34 ounces.

The total solids of these contents vary from 11.2 to 24.3 ounces; or in greater detail, as below:—

Thus 111 samples of canned tomatoes, packed in what we may call large sized tins, give the following averages:—

Average capacity of the can....	37 ounces.
" total contents.....	34 "
" Solid "	18 "
" Water "	16 "

The capacity of the largest sized tin in which these vegetables are packed is fairly constant, the variation being about 1 oz. in either direction.

The total content of the can averages about 3 ounces less than the capacity of the can. This space being either vacuous or containing air.

The solid matter of these contents is of course, the true measure of the value of the article, equal quality being assumed. While the average amount of solids is 18 ounces this varies between very wide limits, viz., from 11.2 oz. to 24.3 oz; which means that some samples have fully twice the value of others. There is no doubt that some regulation is necessary here.

I think it would be reasonable to require a minimum of 20 oz. solids in cans of the size now being considered.

It may be well to say that the solids above referred to are not the dry solid matter of the tomato, but, the moist solids retained on cheese cloth. The weighed total content of the can is poured upon cheese cloth and allowed to drain as long as drops fall at intervals not longer than 5 seconds. The water which passes through is then weighed, and this weight subtracted from the weight of total contents. The remainder in the weight of the solid matter.

Medium Size.

6 samples vary from 855 cc. to 875 cc. or 31 ounces.
17 samples vary from 875 cc. to 900 cc. or 32 ounces.
1 sample is of 980 cc. or 36 ounces.

The last sample referred to may perhaps belong to the preceding group.

With three exceptions, the cans of this size were procured in British Columbia, and it may be that packers ship the smaller tins to distant points to reduce cost of freight. The solid matter in these samples varies in amount from 12.5 oz. to 20.8 oz. and averages 16.3 ounces. More in detail, as follows:—

Small Size.

Five samples are contained in tins of about 650 cc. size (23 ozs.). The solids range from 9.5 to 14.4 ounces and average 11.7 ozs. The ratio of solid content to size of can (11.7: 23) is 0.5 being practically identical with that for the other sizes. It thus appears that the size of the package is a guide to the actual amount of tomato pulp contained therein, on a basis of average results as found in this inspection.

If I am justified in holding that 20 ounces of solids is a reasonable content for a 37 ounce tin, then a medium sized tin of 32 ounces should contain 17 ounces of solids, and a small tin of 23 ounces should contain 12.5 ounces.

On this basis 52 samples of the large size, or 47 per cent of the whole, contains less than normal quantity, and a considerable number of these are very far below the standard suggested. Of the medium size tins, 17 samples or 70% of the whole contains less than the standard requires.

Of the small size 3 samples or 60% of the number contain less than the standard requires.

The State of Ohio requires that standard tomatoes, should be packed to have a gross weight of 36 ounces of fruit, exclusive of juice. For a higher grade, the gross weight must be 38 ounces, with not less than 20 ounces of fruit.

In view of the great disparity of values shown in this widely used article of food, I am of the opinion that a standard should be legalized under the provisions of 6-7 Edward VII, Chapter 27, "THE MEAT AND CANNED FOODS ACT" and the amendment thereto, which Act is administered by the Department of Agriculture, and I hope that the results here placed on record will be found of service to the Department of Agriculture should it decide on establishing such a standard.

I beg to recommend the publication of this report as Bulletin No. 246.
