We call your attention to our large CHART, on the *Divisions of the Brain*, the *Cranial Nerves*, their *Origin*, Arrangement, principal Branches and Distribution, with the *Ganglia* connected, also the special function of *Nervous* tissue so far as understood, with the *Nervous Arc* and a diagram of the *Afferent* and *Efferent Nerves*, as well as a plan of the Intellectual Operations of the *Mind*, especially prepared for Practitioners and Medical Students. The arrangement of the Nerves, &c., is due to Professor Ford (Ann Arbor University), whose small Chart was kindly presented to us for examination. At the suggestion of Dr. Hingston, on the method of arrangement, &c., we undertook the publication of this work, and although the expenses naturally accompanying such a Chart are large, still we have received the greatest support from nearly all the medical gentlemen of Montreal, and especially the two Faculties of Medicine.

Although several Charts on the Cranial Nerves have been before the public for many years, and with considerable merit, still they have either been too concise or wholly unsuitable for Students; we, therefore, from experience in our Medical studios, and after consultation with skilled Anatomists, publish this one, as being more copious and suitable for Canadian Colleges than any which have preceded it. We have added several notes on the Nervous System which will be entirely novel and useful to Students, and lead to further investigation into the connection of Electricity and Nervous force. Having received valuable hints from Wilson and Gray's Anatomy, also from the works of Willis and Sæmmering, Paget and Draper's Physiologies, and the Lectures of the Professor of Physiology, McGill University (Dr. Fraser), as well as several experienced practitioners and well-known Anatomists of this city, particularly Drs. Hingston and Bibaud, who kindly corrected the proof for us. We therefore the more cheerfully offer it to the *working* Student as a valuable aid in the *dry study of the Cranial Nerves*; to the various Medical Colleges of this country, and the United States, and particularly those with whom we have been connected, as a memento of our esteem, and to those Medical gentlemen of this city who are ever ready to assist any effort which is for the advancement of Medical Science and the welfare of Students.

As this Chart is only useful to Medical Practitioners and Students, we are reluctantly compelled to charge Subscribers \$1 per sheet; on canvas, \$1.50; varnished and on rollers, \$2.25.
