GUNBOATS FIRED 80 SHOTS

Detailed Account of the Bombardment of Matanzas.

Excellent Gunnery of the American Marines—One Shot from the Puritan Caused Great Destruction—Engagement Lasted Only 15 Minutes—Spanish Gunners Shot Wild—None of the American Vessels Hit.

New York, April 28.—A despatch by Key West from a correspondent of The Herald, who was a witness of the bombardment of Matanzas by the American ships, says: Admiral Sampson this afternoon bombarded, silenced and pretty well destroyed the Spanish batteries in Matanzas, Cuba.

Not one of the American ships was struck, the Spanish gunners being wild. There is as yet no means of knowing the number of dead and wounded on the Spanish side. It must be a heavy toll.

While the New York, Puritan and Cincinnati were reconnoitering in force for the purpose of locating and destroying the formidable defenses constructed, the flagships were fired on by the batteries on Point Bahucava and Point Maya, guarding the entrance of the harbor.

The New York fired broadsides. The New York replied, firing her forward eight-inch gun from the port side. She steamed boldly in between the batteries and soon blazed away with both broadsides at them.

After waiting in vain for the Spanish to renew the engagement the ships withdrew, leaving both batteries in ruins. The Puritan struck the battery with wonderful accuracy, and blew up a portion of it.

When Rear-Admiral Sampson, on the flagship New York, left the cruising ground to pay a visit to Matanzas and Cardenas, he made up his mind that something had to be done with the very aggressive Spanish artillerymen who were manning the batteries out that way.

At Matanzas the New York found the monitor Puritan and the cruiser Cincinnati, which have been blockading the port. Admiral Sampson decided to make a reconnaissance in force, for the three-fold purpose of locating the batteries, discovering the kind of guns they mounted, and, if possible, stopping the work of fortifying.

The Spanish Fleet Awaiting Attack. An official despatch from Manila, capital of the Philippine Islands, received today, says the Spanish squadron, which has taken up a position near Cavite, is still awaiting the arrival of the United States squadron, under the command of Admiral Clegg.

Excellent Gunnery of the American Marines—One Shot from the Puritan Caused Great Destruction—Engagement Lasted Only 15 Minutes—Spanish Gunners Shot Wild—None of the American Vessels Hit.

New York, April 28.—A despatch by Key West from a correspondent of The Herald, who was a witness of the bombardment of Matanzas by the American ships, says: Admiral Sampson this afternoon bombarded, silenced and pretty well destroyed the Spanish batteries in Matanzas, Cuba.

Not one of the American ships was struck, the Spanish gunners being wild. There is as yet no means of knowing the number of dead and wounded on the Spanish side.

While the New York, Puritan and Cincinnati were reconnoitering in force for the purpose of locating and destroying the formidable defenses constructed, the flagships were fired on by the batteries on Point Bahucava and Point Maya, guarding the entrance of the harbor.

The New York fired broadsides. The New York replied, firing her forward eight-inch gun from the port side. She steamed boldly in between the batteries and soon blazed away with both broadsides at them.

After waiting in vain for the Spanish to renew the engagement the ships withdrew, leaving both batteries in ruins. The Puritan struck the battery with wonderful accuracy, and blew up a portion of it.

When Rear-Admiral Sampson, on the flagship New York, left the cruising ground to pay a visit to Matanzas and Cardenas, he made up his mind that something had to be done with the very aggressive Spanish artillerymen who were manning the batteries out that way.

At Matanzas the New York found the monitor Puritan and the cruiser Cincinnati, which have been blockading the port. Admiral Sampson decided to make a reconnaissance in force, for the three-fold purpose of locating the batteries, discovering the kind of guns they mounted, and, if possible, stopping the work of fortifying.

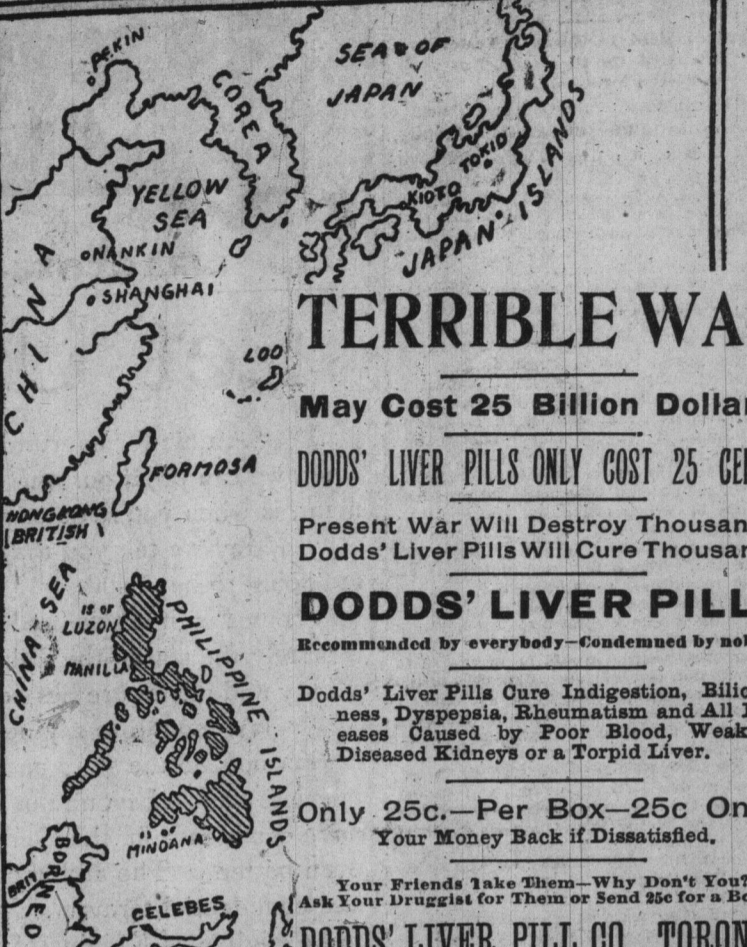
