Shipping Notes. The Yarmouth Herald states that intelligence has been received that on the 30th January, on board ship Peter Young, Oscar Churchill fell from aloft and was so severely injured that he died within two minutes. The deceased was a son of Capt. Samuel Churchill, of Yarmouth, and was 16 years of age.

The brig was a new vessel of her first voyage, registered 870 tons, was built at Londonderry, N. S., and was owned by Captain Urquhart. She cost \$25,000 and is fully insured.

Destroyed by Fire.—The schooner John Stewart, Boston master, from St. John for Halifax, with lime, while being got under weigh at Sheet Harbor on the 1st inst., at which place she had been frozen up since the 28th Jan., was found to be on fire. Finding it impossible to save the vessel, the captain, turned his attention to the gear, and succeeded in saving the most of her remaining cargo and sails. After burning for 6 hours the schooner sank in 10 fathoms of water. The vessel is owned in Halifax and is insured for \$12,000, her cargo for \$700.
