and out expectations of aid and reinforcements from the United States reflecting that there are thousands of British born in the United States who, if they could be induced to return to their native Country, preserve their attachment to their native Country, and would be induced to do so.

And Whereas these parties have held out expectation to the inhabitants of the United States—not reflecting the subjects, who though Emigrants to that Country, preserve their land and to their Sovereign, and who are ready should to support the Government and put down any insurrection.

And Whereas some of these insurgents have already now made and from the spirit and zeal displayed in the Country—their escape is rendered almost impossible.

And Whereas there is reason to fear that some persons disaffection may harbour, conceal, or assist these fugitives from justice:

Now I do hereby offer a reward of FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS PERSONAL to persons who shall apprehend the said JAMES McMAHON, and bring him to justice—and a *Free Pardon* will be given to any person or persons who shall have given information respecting or having committed any murder who shall arrest and bring him to justice.

And I do caution all persons not to harbour, conceal, or assist these fugitives, since by so doing they will commit a high treason, which will incur the most severe and penal character.

And I do further express my warmest thanks and admiration to all the loyal and faithful subjects, whose exertions against the rebels have been so successful, and have compelled them to flight and dispersion. I am using every power at my command for their safety and security, and for bringing to immediate justice the invaders of their country.

Given under my hand and Seal at Arms at Drumcondra, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Two, in the second year of King George IV's Reign the Second.
