American Embassy at Berlin Instructed to Make Enquiries Concerning Loss of American Citizens on Torpedoed Marina and Rowanmore.

## MARINA FIRST VESSEL ON WHICH CITIZENS OF

 UNITED STATES HAVVE BEEN LOST IN WAR ZONE SINCE SINKING OF SUSSEX.| Washington, oct. 31.-Germany has been asked to furnish the United states with any information the Imperial government may have concerning the sinking by submarines of the British steamors Marina and Rowanmore. The request was forwarded, it became known tonight, through the American embassy at Berlin. <br> It Is understood the state department took this step without waiting for full reports from British sources and survivors of the ships, because it would be considered desirable to assemble, at the earliest possible moment, complete information, particularly regarding the Marina, on which several American horse tenders apparently lost their lives. The request is informal, and is intended in no sense as a intimation that German submarines have violated international law or the pledges of the German government to the United States. |
