GENERAL.

THE CANADIAN FERRY.

The Opinion of an Intelligent Observer.

(From the London Morning Advertiser, Oct. 13.)

The establishment of the Dominion of Canada was a deeply interesting experiment. "Ours" British Antipathy to the Dominion, and there maintained in their integrity? We all had fondly hoped that a triumphant affirmative could be the only reply. But, alas! the Confederation of the North American States has barely been the sixth year of its existence, when the Pacific Railway scandal, brewed abroad by the Press, by telegraph, and by Parliamentary assuents, caused and warmest friends of the new experiment in government to waver in their opinions and to look with doubt and forebodings to its future. So dense a cloud of suspicion rested on the Government of the Dominion, so grave and so specific were the charges made against it, based as they were solemnly assumed on evidence of the most irrefragable character, that we on this side of the ocean might well be pardoned if our faith in the vitality of British constitutional principles, and our confidence in the capacity of withstanding the shock of transplanting, was somewhat shaken. The Royal Commission, however, has now (nearly) closed its labors, and the field of vision has become somewhat clearer. The haze has resolved itself into a more defined aspect, and we can at length see the form and substance which the scandal must ultimately assume.

Mr. Huntington, who only holds a subordinate commission in the Opposition ranks, was selected to lead the assault. That the gentleman is merely the mouthpiece of another behind the scenes is now evident, from the ridiculous position in which he has placed himself by furnishing a long list of witnesses who, according to the brief entrusted to him by his employers, were to establish the guilt of the Ministry beyond dispute, but many of whom, when sworn, stated that they knew nothing whatever of the matter, and were at a loss to know why they had been summoned; while the others, who were named in the most emphatic manner statements and charges relied on by Mr. Huntington, were merely the names of a multitude of names paraded before the public as evidence of ministerial guilt, who were clearly the mere accessories, and supernumeraries hurried upon the stage to swell the numbers of the actors and save the place from the impending damnation, was very great in favor of the Government.

The indirect effect, however, of the evidence of ministerial guilt, which he has placed himself by furnishing a long list of witnesses who, according to the brief entrusted to him by his employers, were to establish the guilt of the Ministry beyond dispute, but many of whom, when sworn, stated that they knew nothing whatever of the matter, and were at a loss to know why they had been summoned; while the others, who were named in the most emphatic manner statements and charges relied on by Mr. Huntington, were merely the names of a multitude of names paraded before the public as evidence of ministerial guilt, who were clearly the mere accessories, and supernumeraries hurried upon the stage to swell the numbers of the actors and save the place from the impending damnation, was very great in favor of the Government.

The negative testimony, however, would not have been sufficient to save the Ministry from the imputation of the guilt of the witnesses did they not testify some of the facts of the case.
