THE WINKLEY TARIFF BILL.

REPORT OF THE U.S. SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE.

WASHINGTON, June 18.—In the Senate today Mr. Morrill, from the Committee on Finance, reported back the House Tariff bill with the proposed amendments. He said it was not expected that it would be brought up for consideration earlier than a week from next Monday. Following are the principal changes made by the Senate Committee in the bill:
The glassware classification are changed and above a certain amount are to be taxed at 10 per cent.
Steel rails are reduced from 43 to 42 per cent.
