BY-LAWS.

==

- 1. An Annual Fee of One Dollar must be paid by all members.
- 2. Any member failing to render the part assigned to her on any programme, except when due to illness, must either furnish a fitting substitute, or pay a fine of 25 cents.
- Concerts must begin promptly on time, and no person shall enter during the performance of a number.
- 4. Visitors to the city introduced by members are welcome at the Club Concerts.
- 5. Twelve members of the Executive Committee shall form a quorum. Members of the Committee absenting themselves from business meetings, except from unavoidable causes, shall pay a fine of 10 cents.
- 6. Encores are strictly prohibited at all regular concerts.
- 7. Gentlemen can become associate members upon payment of the annual fee of one dollar.
