leaved, have their heads too full of the state of things which existed years back. They had better waken up and try to realize what the state of things is which actually exists to-day.

Why cannot the brush carts be used on soft days to remove the mud from the black-paved streets in winter with as much success as they are used to remove the dust and dirt in summer? If the slush were swept off the roadway and promptly carted away, when the hard weather did come, containing would be much better, and during the mild period the blessings that would fall from owners of vehicles on the aldermanic head would compensate in some measure for the curses that are usually hurled at that venerable pate.

Much sympathy is felt for O'Donnell's fate because Carey was an informer. A proof that this sympathy is widespread lies in the fact that a liberal subscription of quarters, half and whole dollars is being taken up in Canada to aid the New York society for the suppression of spies, informers and other inimical to the Irish cause. O'Donnell did not murder Carey so much because he was an informer as because of the people he informed against.

The reference of the boundary dispute to the jury council by Ontario and Manitoba provides for the settlement of the western boundary—which is the real issue between the two provinces; but there is still an unsettled issue between Ontario and Canada as to the northern boundary of the first mentioned. Why does not the Dominion form a third party to the cause and have the whole question? In a temperate article on the subject the Monetary Times says the first question, that of the western boundary, is almost sure to result in a decision favorable to Ontario.

The excuse given by the street commissioner of New York for not cleaning the streets is unique and we commend it to the aldermanic candidates at the nominations on Monday next. He says that an estimate of the surface of the street, the depth of the snow and the capacity of the carts, proves that by diligent work the city carts could not possibly do the work of removing four hundred million cubic yards of slush under four hundred days, or until Feb. 1, 1885. As by that date more snow and slush will have accumulated, it must be comforting to New Yorkers to reflect that there is a possibility of their having to dwell in their fiftieth year for all time to come.

Bradshaw makes his reappearance as regularly as the winter itself. He says he will forcibly take possession of his seat on the reassembling of parliament. Poor fellow! His is a case in which, if reason does not prevail, force cannot. And the very suggestion of the use of force to compel a recognition of his rights is apt to make people think that his logic is becoming as weak as his physical strength.

Just now there appears a danger of the aphorism of force at the expense of reason. It is not meant that muscle is being exercised over brain. That is scarcely the case to-day as in former times. But verbal force is receiving the place of honor in preference to argument. Writers are manifesting an inclination to adopt the short, pithy, declamatory style which dignifies more of sound and fury than of calm reasoning. The short, disjointed denunciations are surely not pleasant reading than a series of easily running, nicely woven, well-turned paragraphs in which reason and logic have sway.

New York has this season had five or six times more snow than Toronto. A snow battle between the street-car company and our merchants is as almost an annual spectacle, and therefore by no means unusual. In New York however it is something new. Mayor, corporation and street cleaning commission have all been appealed to in the interests of the people. But in vain, the railway companies persist in clearing their tracks, and the people are equally obstinate in shoveling back. The battle will only cease to be waged with the dissolution of the snow. There is one consolation for our New York friends, namely, that the constant stirring up of the beautiful will hasten its conversion into mud and slush.

It is gratifying to know that the dullness in trade has reached its worst and that there is every indication of a change for the better. A conversation with several of our business men yesterday convinced us of this. Each agreed that the country dealers had so rigidly observed a conservative policy during the fall and winter trade that now they were beginning to find their stocks of staples so low that replenishment was an absolute necessity. Orders were being received daily showing this to be the case.

In the opinion of the New York Sun "there is danger, however, of a serious squeeze in certain specialties, like the Canadian Pacific for instance. That stock is heavily overvalued in the New York market, and the Canadians, after having obtained the guarantee of 3 per cent. from the government, have succeeded in creating a demand for it in London. Some 28,000 shares are said to have been shipped on Saturday. A stock paying 5 per cent. of which 5 are guaranteed looks cheap to the British investor at \$22 to \$25 a share."

In common with other papers, The Toronto World published an associated press despatch, declaring Mapleson's opera season at Montreal a lamentable failure. Judging from the notices in the local press the statement is wide of the truth. The Gazette and Herald both agree that the audience on Wednesday, the opening night, was one of the finest that ever assembled in Montreal. Over the performance, Le Travolta being the opera, they are intensely enthusiastic. If he had met with blank failure it is scarcely possible that Mapleson would have consented to stay over an additional day (to-day), as he has done, in order to give a representation at popular prices. We have recognized that both the Montreal and Ottawa associated press agents are unreliable, but for want of a better service we are sometimes compelled to use their reports. BUSINESS OF FIRE

Mr. Norman Lockyer Believes They Were Caused by the Java Earthquake.

In a long contribution to the London Times Mr. Lockyer brings the light of science to bear on the atmospheric phenomena which have lately been surprising and delighting Europe and America. The unusual ponds are reported to have derived their wonderful complexion from a plentiful dust of pumice stones. Meteorologists have been enabled to track Krakatoa from its original site in the Straits of Sunda to the hills above Java. Madras and other distant points, Java, India, to the Seychelles and Mauritius, to the Cape and the Great Coast, South West Africa, were included. About the period at which, with the prevailing currents of the upper air, and in the anticipated direction, winds blowing in the atmosphere would be in Europe. European skies have been visited with a succession of gorgeous sunrises and sunsets. The volcanic eruptions in London and its vicinity have been best described by European skies as they surrounded Java. As it has been said that the sun's rays in the air is the chief cause of the sunset color, normally, Mr. Lockyer inquires if there is excess of aqueous vapor at present. A question of higher authority than the Astronomer Royal for Scotland, Professor Plazza Smyth, and the evidence which Mr. Lockyer lists as follows: "I do not write as a partisan, but even were I one I should still point out that there are important gaps in the evidence and that there are some difficulties in the way, and it is desirable to know whether they will be increased or diminished by further observations."

The so-called edition de luxe of standard authors is evidently not a paying proposition in London. The London correspondent of the New York Tribune recently asked an intelligent bookseller the price of a coveted edition of Dickens, and he replied: "I should like to see you at the Fielding at that price; what this means may be seen from a cursory comparison of nominal and real prices. The Dickens, for instance, was published at \$150. It was quoted at \$225. It cost the bookseller \$100. He is now selling it for \$100. He is now ready to give me \$100 to sell it for a little over \$50."

Professor Favett, postmaster-general of Cambridge, is a very favorite at Cambridge university, where, says the Boston Advertiser, his lectures on political economy are the most interesting and practical.
