In preparing this supplement to the Kilgour Report on the Resources for the Study of International Relations in Canadian Universities, the decision was made to include up-to-date information obtained since the original Report was issued, within the categories set out by that Report.

To obtain the necessary data, questionnaires were sent out to the Heads of Departments of Political Science and to the Deans of the relevant Faculties in Universities and Colleges across Canada. These requested the following information:

1. New degree and diploma courses available in the study of International Relations and in Area Studies; and new majors and honours programmes available in these fields within the various degree courses.
2. Additions, deletions, and corrections in course listings pertaining to the study of International Relations and Area Studies; including courses offered by the Department of Political Science, and any relevant courses offered by other departments of the University.
3. Revisions of staff listings, to include new staff new fields of interest, and deletions from staff.
4. Additional information, to include plans and proposals, information on new committees and institutes, and on new library resources.

Every University replied, and on the basis of these questionnaires, study of University calendars for 1970-1971, and correspondence which resulted from the original Report, the present supplement was prepared. Because of the relatively limited number of revisions for any one University, arrangement of the information in these same four general categories was thought to give sufficient definition to the data.

We wish to offer our sincere thanks for the generous co-operation of all those concerned in this field who sent us the necessary information.

Le présent supplément au rapport Kilgour sur Les Ressources pour l'Etude des Relations Internationales dans les Universités canadiennes est une mise à jour de l'étude originale à partir de renseignements obtenus depuis la publication de l'étude originale en septembre 1969. La cueillette des renseignements s'est faite, en grande partie, à l'aide des réponses aux questionnaires qui furent adressés aux doyens des facultés et aux directeurs des départements concernés dans les universités et collèges du Canada. Par les questionnaires on a cherché à obtenir les renseignements suivants:

1. Nouveaux diplômes relatifs à l'étude des relations internationales et aux études régionales; nouveaux programmes aux niveaux du premier cycle et des études supérieures dans les mêmes domaines.
2. Additions, suppressions, corrections apportées dans la liste des cours de relations internationales et d'études régionales offerts par les différents départements des universités et par les facultés de droit.
3. Changements dans le corps professoral; et nouveaux domaines d'enseignement et d'étude chez les professeurs.
4. Renseignements supplémentaires sur les projets à l'étude ou en cours, sur les nouveaux comités et instituts et sur les nouvelles ressources des Bibliothèques.

En plus des réponses aux questionnaires, on a consulté les prospectus de 1970-71 et la correspondance qu'a suscitée la parution du rapport Kilgour. Vu le nombre relativement restreint de changements et modifications rapportés par chaque université, les renseignements ont été regroupés selon les catégories de renseignements recherchés.

Nos sincères remerciements vont à tous ceux et celles qui ont collaboré aimablement à la préparation du présent supplément.

Material in this supplement is grouped in four categories.

1. New degrees or diplomas

This includes degrees or diplomas available in the fields of International Relations, and in Area Studies, not listed in the Kilgour Report.

New majors or honours programmes

This includes concentrations in the fields of International Relations and Area Studies available in degree courses, not listed in the Kilgour Report.

2. Courses

Add

This lists courses offered in the fields of International Relations and Area Studies, not mentioned in the Kilgour Report. It notes whether the course is available to graduates or undergraduates, and names the department responsible.

Delete

This lists courses mentioned in the Kilgour Report which are no longer available.

3. Staff

Add

This lists new staff members and fields of interests and corrections in original listings in the Kilgour Report.
