**SENATOR COX DO AS

**Policy Holders of the Canada Life

compel Mr. Cox to repay to the said com-

the company. The plaintiffs ask for an
injunction to restrain the defendant from
"further acting in such a manner." From
the statement of claim, which will be filed
in the morning, the following extracts are
taken: "About 1880 the defendant

company at Peterboro, and he was appointed
agent of the company at Toronto.

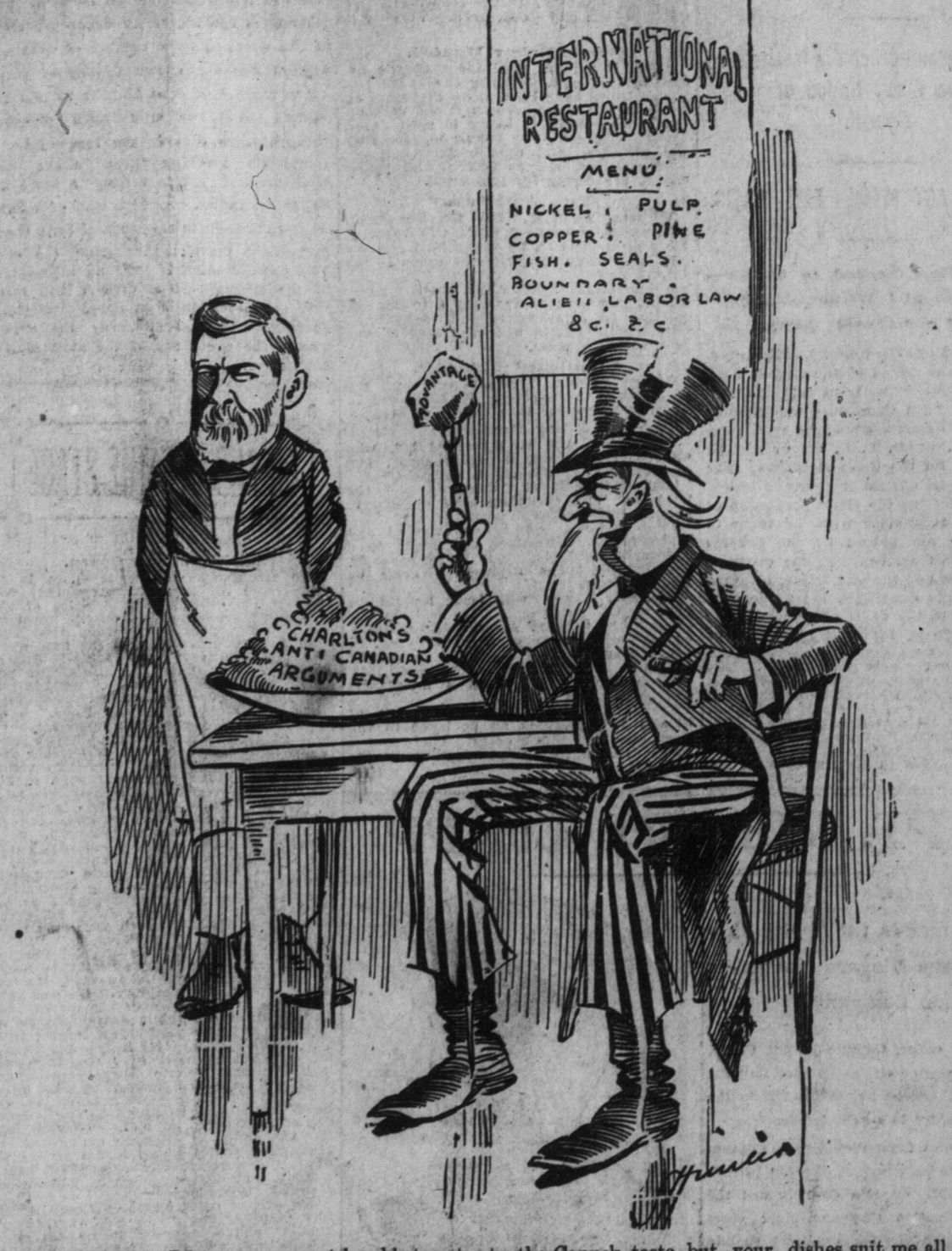

On his person was found a Dime Savings and Banking Co. book, No. 15,585, in favor of Mrs. Charles Warner, and signed Charles Nell, financial secretary. About 40 years of age.
