## An Aut to consolidate the debt of the Town of Galt.

THEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Galt have petitioned Preamble. to be authorized by law to borrow on the debentures of the said Town a sum not exceeding sixteen thousand pounds, for certain purposes and under certain restrictions in the said petition set forth, and it his expedient that the prayer of their said petition should be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. It shall be lawful to and for the Mayor and Council of the said Council may Town of Galt to raise by way of loan upon the credit of the debentures raise not exhereinafter mentioned, from any person or persons, body or bodies cor- ceeding £16, 10 porate, either in this Province or in Great Britain or elsewhere, who may be willing to lend the same, a sum of money not exceeding the sum of sixteen thousand pounds of lawful money of Canada.

II It shall be lawful for the Mayor of the said Town of Galt, from Mayor to issue time to time, to cause to be issued debentures of the said Town under Debentures to the Corporation seal, signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the under direction of Countersigned by the tion of Countersigned Treasurer of the said Town for the time being, in such sums not exceed-cil. ing in the whole the said sum of sixteen thousand pounds, as the Council shall direct and appoint, and the principal sum secured by the said debenfures and the interest accuring thereon, shall be made payable neither in this Province, in Great Britain or elsewhere, as the said Council shall deem expedient or necessary.

III. So much of the said loan so to be raised as aforesaid as shall be Application of necessary for the purpose, shall be applied by the said Mayor and Coun-said loan,-to cil of the said Town of Galt in the redemption of the debentures out-25 outstanding for the building of a Bridge across the Grand River as per dependences. By-law number sixty-one, of the late Village Council, of the late Village of Galt, now the said Town of Galt, amounting to about nineteen bundred pounds, for grading and gravelling certain streets and building a Bridge across Mill Creek, as per By-law number sixty-seven, of the M said late Village Council, amounting to about twelve hundred and fortyseven pounds;—For purchasing a site for the Central School as per By-law number sixty-nine, of the said late Village Council, amounting to about seven hundred and fifty pounds; -For erecting the Central School House, as per By-law number seventy; of the said late Village 40 Council, amounting to about five thousand and forty pounds;—For building a Bridge across the Grand River near the Railroad Station as per By tw number seventy-eight of the said Town Council amounting to about one thousand pounds;—For meeting the liabilities incurred in erceting the Market House and Town Hall, as per By-law seventy-nine

of the said Town Council, amounting to about two thousand five hundred pounds;—For building a Bridge across the Grand River at the Dickson Mills, as per By-law number eighty of the said Town Council, amounting to about one thousand pounds;—For assisting in meeting the expenditure of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, as per 5 By-law number eighty-four, of the said Town Council, amounting to about two thousand four hundred pounds;—And the Treasurer of the said Town is hereby authorized and empowered, on receiving instruction so to do from the Town Council, to call in such debentures of the said Town as may have heretofore been issued by virtue of "e afore to be issued under this Act.

Special rate for discharge of debentures issued under this Act. IV. For the payment, satisfaction and discharge of the debentures to be issued by virtue of this Act, it shall and may be lawful for the Council of the said Town of Galt, and they are hereby required, to impose 15 a special rate per annum, (over and above and in addition to all other rates to be levied in each year, and over and above the interest to be payable on such debentures) which shall be sufficient to form a sinking fund of two per cent. per annum for that purpose.

How monies so raised shall be invested.

V. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer of the said Town of Galt, 20 from time to time, to invest all sums of money raised by special rate for the sinking fund provided in this Act, either in the debentures provided for by this Act, or in any debentures issued by the Government of Canada, or in such other securities as the Governor of this Province shall by order in Council direct or appoint, and to apply all dividends or in-25 terest on the said sinking fund to the extinction of the debts created by this Act.

Council may repeal previous By-laws authorizing special rates. VI. For and notwithstanding any provision, clause, matter or thing contained in any Act of the Parliament of this Province to the contrary, it shall and may be lawful for the Council of the said Town of Galt, after 30 having called in and paid the debentures described in this Act, to repeal the By-laws of the said Council or of the Council of the late Village of Galt, authorizing the levying of special rates for the purpose of paying and satisfying the said debentures.

Certain provisions of 18 Vict. cap. 133 not to apply to this Act.

VII. The provisions of the statute of this Province, passed in the so eighteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, chaptered one hundred and thirty-three, and intituled An Act to require that all By-laws of City, Town, Village or Township Councils in Upper Canada, for raising money upon the credit of such City, Town, Village or Township Corporations, shall be approved by a majority of the Municipal Electors be-40 fore they come into force, shall not apply to this Act, or to any By-law or By-laws to be passed under the authority thereof.

Public Act. VIII. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
